

## FaceBook Q & A

**Students driving to school** will have to be checked for temperature at their school building entrance before they are admitted. If siblings or other passengers rode in the vehicle they too will need to be checked for temperature at their school building entrance before they are admitted.

**The siblings of students** who are determined to have the virus will also have to be quarantined. As will any other students attending Springport Schools who lives with the student who tested positive.

At this time there is not a requirement to have a **Covid-19 test** before a student returns to school. That may change if the state requirements change.

**Students will be checked for a temperature before they are allowed on a bus to ride to school.** An employee other than the bus driver will use a temporal thermometer and record each student's temperature so there is a cumulative database ensuring the health and wellbeing of students and employees. Students discovered to have a temperature at or above 100.4 will not be allowed to enter a school building or ride a bus. Springport Public Schools maintains a 24 hour fever free policy before students are allowed to attend school and/or participate in school related events.

**Students who develop a fever during the school day** will necessarily be isolated from the general student population until a parent, guardian or other family member can arrive to pick-up the student. While the student is in an isolation area they will be accompanied by an adult school employee who is responsible for their wellbeing until a parent, guardian or other family member can arrive to pick-up the student. The parent will notify the school's office when s/he arrives and the student will be brought out to him/her.

At this time **employee health screens** consist of a temporal thermometer and a brief questionnaire to determine temperature and wellness. This screen is currently being successfully used by bus drivers, food service, and volunteers making and delivering meals to families, and for student athletes and coaches participating in conditioning drills. It's anticipated that all employees will screen every day and inform their immediate supervisor of any change in their health.

**If a student needs a device for distance learning** the parent is encouraged to contact the building principal. At this time we are planning to load information onto each device so that the lack of dependable internet service is not a factor hindering learning and instruction.

**The use of shared staff** between building is being examined for ways in which the number of times they travel between buildings might be decreased; health precautions for when they do travel between buildings; as well as traveling from classroom to classroom.

**Parents with questions about Kindergarten Round up** and documentation questions are encouraged to contact the building principal and secretary directly. Electronic enrollment through the District website allows for the upload of all documents.
