Senior Parade, 7/25/2020

- The parade will begin by the Mascot Hall of Fame and will end at the football field.
- Graduating seniors and their families will travel together and **MUST** be in the vehicle at all times, including in the parking lot by the Mascot Hall of Fame. No walking will be allowed. You may decorate your car with signage with the student's name.
- Graduates and their attendees must ride together. If only one of the attendees rides in the car, the other participant will need to park in the non parade-participant parking lot at the high school.
- Cars can begin entering the lot at 10:15.
- All cars need to be in the specified lot by 10:45.
- The parade will begin promptly at 11 am.
- Follow the route and park in the Parade Participant Parking Lot. If you are in need of handicap parking, please call the high school office and let us know so that we can provide you with a handicap parking pass.
- Once parked in the parking lot, graduates will enter the field through the paramedic gate near the parking lot and walk toward the softball field. Guests can enter the field upon their arrival. Entrances will be specified based on where you are sitting. Handicap seating is available in the first row of every section.
- Non parade participants will need to park in the high school parking lot.

Graduation Ceremony, 7/25/2020

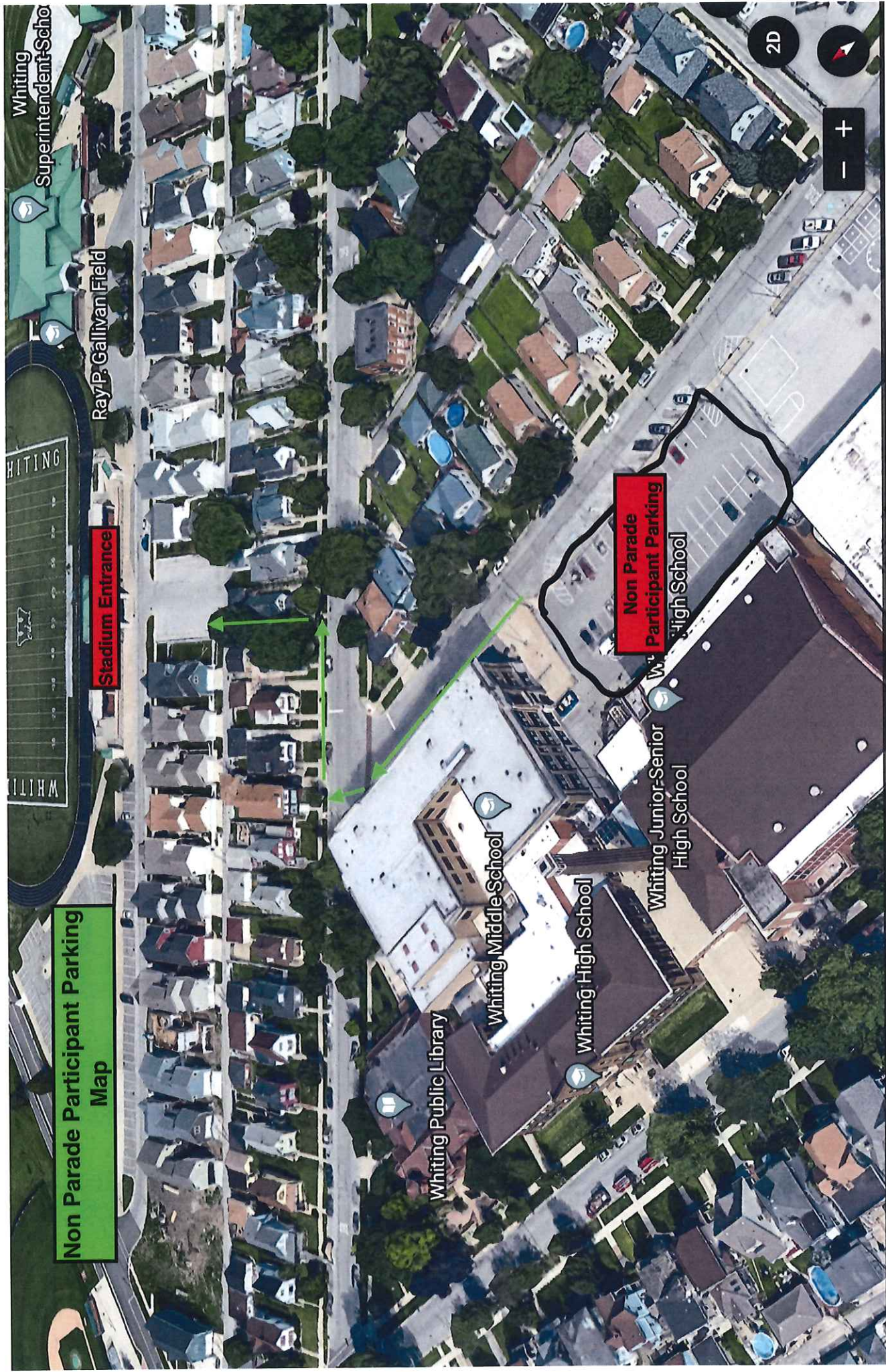
- Entrance to the stadium will begin at 11 am for those not participating in the parade. Parade attendees will enter after they have parked their vehicle.
- Students need to wear their graduation cap and gown for the ceremony.
- Following the parade we will hold a graduation ceremony in which the family members that traveled with the graduating senior will be able to watch from the football bleachers.
- Entrance to the facility will not be allowed without presentation of a ticket. We are only able to accommodate two family members per student.
- Families will sit in the bleachers which will be marked to ensure social distancing.

- In order to comply with CDC and Lake County health department guidelines for social distancing **masks must be worn throughout the entire event.**
- Students and spectators must exit the facility immediately after the ceremony. Families will exit first, followed by the graduating seniors.
- Graduates will be able to remove their mask for their picture. Graduates will be provided with a picture from the day of graduation.
