Distance Learning—Virtual Option

Elementary

- Grade level standards and curriculum will align with state standards.
- Students will be assigned teachers who will be able to answer their questions and guide them through the coursework.
- Devices will be available to all students.
- Students will need to be available for live instruction.

Junior High (Grades 7/8):

- Students will be assigned to content teachers for language arts, math, social studies and science.
- Teachers will be in daily contact with students through instructional videos and content. Grade level standards and curriculum will align with in-person instruction.

High School (Grades 9-12):

- The online platform aligns with state and national standards. Students will be assigned to an instructor who will be able to answer their questions and guide them through the coursework.
- Some electives and dual credit courses may not be available virtually, while others may.

Columbia School District is preparing for any potential waves of interruption to on-campus learning. In the event of a spike in COVID-19 cases and we are placed into a different phase, in accordance with the State of Michigan, a shift in student instructional learning will happen immediately.
