We are here to help your child with a severe allergy have a safe and successful year! There are a few steps for you to take to help in this process:

- 1. Complete the Severe Allergy Questionnaire located in the Allergy folder. You can discuss this with your Healthcare Provider and then give to your child's school nurse.
- 2. Provide the school with a Food Allergy & Anaphylaxis Emergency Care Plan that is completed by your Healthcare Provider and you. (see link in Allergy folder). Be sure to discuss with your provider if your child can carry his/her epinephrine auto-injector (Epi Pen, etc). This needs to be indicated on the Care Plan.
- 3. If a food substitution is needed in the cafeteria, please have your Healthcare Provider fill out the Food Allergy substitution form located in the Allergy folder and provide to the school. Please also visit the Special Meal Accommodation section under Food Service.
