2020-2021 Plan to Return to School

Sallisaw Public School officials will continually and closely monitor student and staff health and community transmission rates of Coronavirus throughout the school year. Decisions regarding a change in educational plans will be based on current health data and made with the advice of local health professionals.

- The 2020-21 school year will begin Monday, August 3. Traditional face to face learning will resume. Social Distancing will be required.
- 2020-2021 enrollment and assessment is required to receive services which includes face to face learning at SALC and online curricula.
- Traditional Sallisaw Public School calendar will be followed. (See Sallisaw Public School website for 2020-21 calendar)
- SALC staff will increase cleaning and sanitizing.
- Students and teachers will have access to sanitizers.
- Masks will be required by students and teachers.
- Visitor access to buildings will be limited.
- Students and teachers must stay home if exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms.
- If a student cannot attend regular class due to COVID-19 symptoms or exposure, they may continue with Distance Learning.
- If school is closed for COVID reasons, a Distance Learning Plan will be given to students attending classes and posted on the Sallisaw Public Schools Adult Education webpage.
