SUPERINTENDENT'S Superintendent Matthew Miller presented the Bullying Report. He commented that, in general, there has been a decrease district wide. The in-house suspension room is being utilized more to try and keep students in attendance.

> Superintendent Miller also mentioned school funding, and the recently released State Adequacy Study. Next year schools will receive \$7,511/per pupil. This study determined the minimum should be \$8,667 and more for low income students and English Language Learners. The study confirms that overall education is "grossly" underfunded.
