POLICY **COMMITTEE** REPORTS

Tom Andrews reported that the committee met and Superintendent Matthew Miller presented new and updated board policies from NEOLA. The committee is recommending the new and updated policies to the full board for first reading.

There was also a discussion about the procedures for interviewing and appointing a new board member.

PERSONNEL COMMITTEE REPORT

Tom Andrews reported the committee met and discussed monitoring GRBS (Grand Rapids Building Services) and the environment in the buildings for teaching and learning. There was a discussion regarding changes of duties and title for the Parchment School District Energy Manager. The committee is recommending the change to the full board for approval.

REPORT

SUPERINTENDENT'S Superintendent Matthew Miller provided a handout regarding School Reform Office (SRO). The SRO is using data that experts denounce as being fundamentally flawed to make monumental decisions that will affect students, schools and communities. The SRO's plan is to close schools building that make the bottom 5% (there will always be a bottom 5%), using the M-Step data. When M-Step was new, Districts were assured that it would not be used for major decisions.

> Superintendent Miller also mentioned that Parchment School District was nominated for the Governors' Energy Excellence Award, Mr. Miller thanked John Madaras for attending the ceremony in Lansing. where Western Michigan University (WMU) took 1st place.

EARLY LEARNING CENTER

Anna Wessing, Parchment Early Learning Center (PELC) Director, updated board members on the PELC programs.

- There is a Star Rating System, five (5) being the highest, and we are currently a four (4). Parchment is providing teacher mentors to work on improving our rating.
- The Pre-K to K connection is working with Kindergarten for Professional Learning Communities (PLC's).

At a recent GSRP (Great Start Readiness Program) advisory committee meeting. Parchment was the only school in the county fully enrolled.
