REPORT

SUPERINTENDENT'S Superintendent Matthew Miller mentioned the 3rd Grade Reading Bill that is currently on the governor's desk awaiting his signature. Superintendent Miller said it is a great effort; however, the state is not going to provide any financial support. If a child is a full year behind in reading they must be retained, with exceptions, and the parent is the only one that can challenge retention of the child.

> Superintendent Miller shared a handout showing State and Parchment School District M-Step Results for 2016. Parchment School District scored above state average on 15 of the 18 tests. Parchment School District is approximately 10% higher than the state in reduced and free lunch rates, which would typically show testing scores below the state average. This represents great work from our students, staff and administrators!
