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Lindsay Public Schools Return to School Plan

On-Campus Instruction

- All Courses/Classes taken at regularly assigned school site
- In-person instruction
- Lindsay curriculum
- If the student test positive for COVID-19 and must be quarantined, Google Classroom/Acellus will be utilized for an allotted time period.

Virtual

- Students report through Google Classroom or Acellus
- Requires semester commitment
- Students take all courses online, away from campus
- Students learning plans are directed and monitored by Acellus and Lindsay teachers
- Classes do not require regular on-campus attendance
- Students cannot participate in extracurricular activities

General Guidelines

Unless mandated otherwise, Lindsay Public Schools will open and operate school as scheduled for the 2020-2021 Academic year. Lindsay Schools will offer Traditional On-Campus Instruction and Virtual Learning. This plan in its entirety is subject to change based upon CDC and State Department of Education guidance, and local data and conditions.

Daily Protocol

- Students and staff are encouraged but **not** required to wear mask or face covering.
- Parents are **strongly** encouraged to observe for COVID-19 symptoms prior to sending students to school each day.
- Parents are encouraged to stay in their respective vehicles when picking up or dropping off students.
- The district will follow CDC and state level recommendations regarding the return to work or school following a positive COVID-19 diagnosis.

Added Safety Measures

- Students will have their temperature checked in the morning upon arriving to school to determine if the student is "fever free." The district is defining "fever free" as being 100 degrees or less.
- Frequent sanitizing of all high traffic and high volume areas.
- Additional sanitation stations will be made available throughout the campus.

Transportation

- The school district recognizes that proper social distancing is impossible while operating a school bus that is filled to capacity.
- The school district will operate buses normally.
- While the buses will operate normally, parents are **strongly** encouraged to transport students if possible.

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FAQs

1. What is Virtual Learning?

A Virtual Learning Program means the student takes all of his/her courses in a virtual setting away from the school. No classes require regular physical attendance. The Virtual Learning option is a minimum of a one semester commitment. If needed, the student will be provided a computer device to further their education.

2. Do I have to declare which option I want my child(ren) to participate in?

Already enrolled students will participate in traditional on campus instruction unless the school is notified by the student's guardian that Virtual Learning is requested.

3. What is Google Classroom?

Google Classroom is a learning management system/portal where students will access their assignments, communication and grades. The system streamlines all the digital tools and contents that teachers and students use, for a simpler, more connected, learning experience.

4. What is Acellus?

Acellus is a content management system that provides an online/digital learning curriculum for students who wish to learn in a fulltime virtual classroom setting.

5. Will I be contacted if my child comes in contact with someone who test positive for COVID-19?

The school district will send out notification when a student or staff member test positive for COVID 19. That student will go to virtual learning for 14 days or more if needed/ staff member will be quarantined for 14 days or more if needed.

6. Will my child be able to participate in extracurricular activities if I choose virtual learning?

No, your child will have to attend on campus instruction to participate in extracurricular activities.

7. If I choose on campus instruction can I switch to virtual at any time?

Yes, but once you choose virtual it is a semester commitment. The student will only be able to return to on campus learning at the beginning of the next semester.
