District Goal 2 Progress Measure 2

The percentage of TISD students completing two or more advanced/dual credit courses will increase by an average of at least 3% annually over the next five years (from 38.8% in 2016 to 53.8% in 2021).

- Baseline (2016) 38.8%
- Year 1 Target (2017) 41.8%




Completion of Two or More Advanced/Dual-Credit Courses (Annual Graduates)

Career Ready


- Earn an industry certification (TEA list)
