Progress Measure 2

The percentage of TISD students completing two or more advanced/dual credit courses will increase by an average of at least 3% annually over the next five years.

- **Baseline (2016) – 38.8%***
- **Year 1 Target (2017) – 41.8%* (43.5% Actual)**
- **Year 2 Target (2018) – 44.8%***

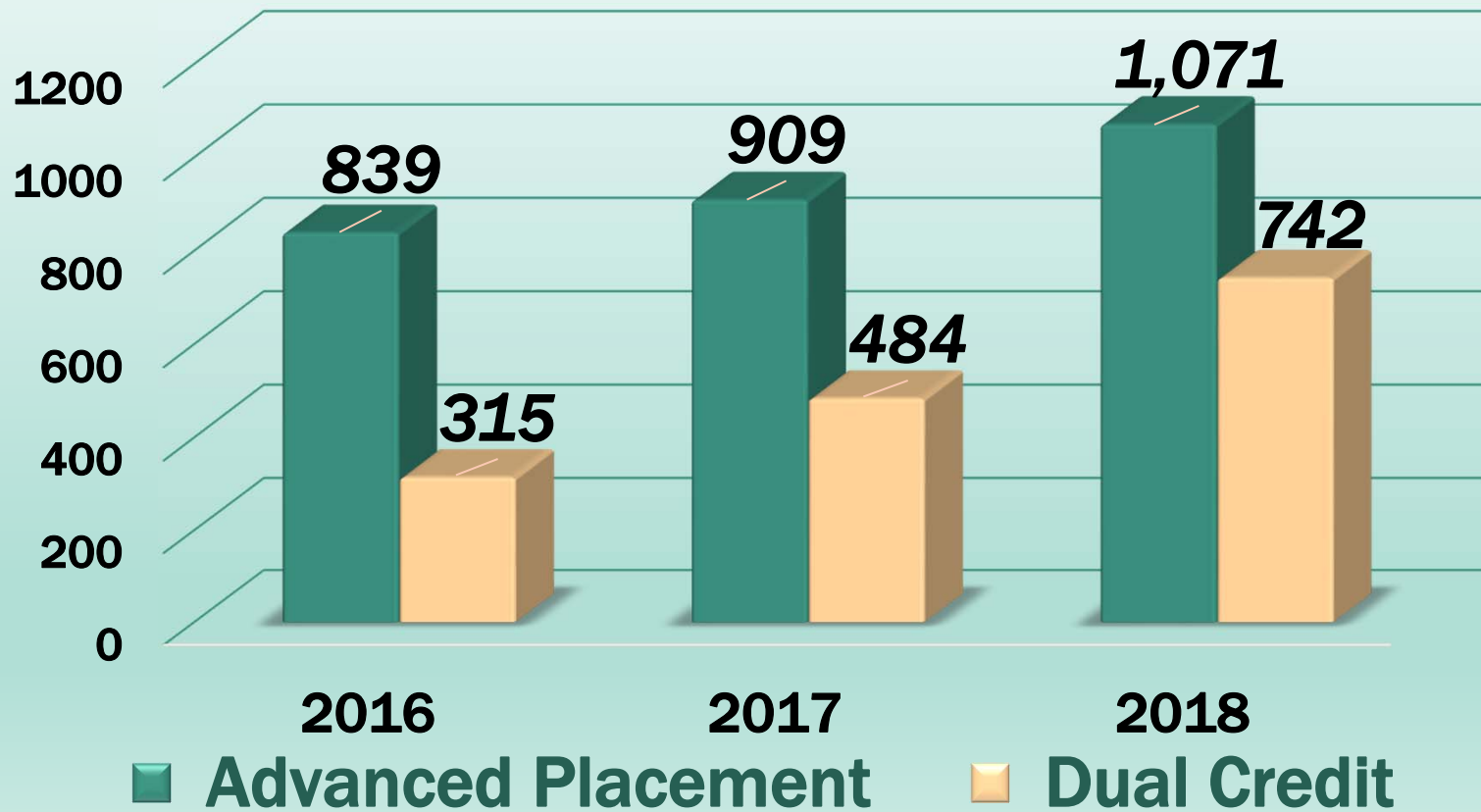
- 1. Meet Texas Success Initiative criteria on the ACT, SAT, or TSIA (ELA & Mathematics)**
