Virtual Desktop Hardware

- Current Server Hardware Outdated
- Reviewed 10+ options from various hardware vendors
- Chose the HPE Synergy solution due to superior performance, cost, physical attributes and future upgradability
- Enables remaining campuses (2-HS, 3-MS, 2-ES) to be upgraded from antiquated staff laptops and supports the move to Windows 10
- Provides increased performance and speed across the district
- Total cost for hardware and 5 years maintenance support \$2.7M

VMware Enterprise Software

- Software that supports the virtual server and desktop environments
- Allows for anywhere, anytime access from any device to all district resources
- Current Enterprise License Agreement (ELA) ending
- "Buy as you go" pricing increases substantially each year
- "Buy as you go" payments would total \$4.1M over the next 5 years
- Unprotected 6th year would cost \$711,888

VMware Enterprise Software

- A new ELA reduces the cost over 5 years to \$1.7M, saving \$2.4M
- Protects the 6th year at pre-negotiated cost of \$214K, saving \$497K
- Total savings of <u>\$2.9M</u> over 6 year period



- 4. Earn a TEA approved industry-based certification
- 5. Enlist in the U.S. Armed Forces



■ Students who took at least 1 AP Exam ■ AP Exam-takers with at least one score of 3+




2018 AP Exam Mean Scores

Tyler ISD AP students outperformed Texas AP students on the mean score on 17 of 24 AP exams.

AP 2018 AP Mean Score Comparison







- AP Scholar Students who receive scores of 3 or higher on three or more AP exams.
- AP Scholar with Honor Average at least 3.25 on all AP exams taken AND scores of 3+ on four or more AP exams.
- AP Scholar with Distinction Average at least 3.5 on all AP exams taken AND scores of 3+ on five or more AP exams.
- National AP Scholar Average at least 4 on all AP exams taken AND scores of 4+ on eight or more AP exams.
