GAOE

Whenever an employee is absent from work and is receiving workers

compensation benefits due to a work-related injury or is receiving district paid

disability insurance, the employee may use available paid sick leave to supple-

ment the workers compensation or district paid disability insurance payments.

Workers compensation benefits and FMLA benefits provided in a board ap-

proved plan shall run concurrently if both are applicable.

In no event shall the employee be entitled to a combination of workers

compensation benefits, district paid disability insurance, and salary in excess

of his/her full salary. Available paid sick leave may be used for this purpose

until 1) available paid sick leave benefits are exhausted; 2) the employee re-

turns to work; or 3) employment is terminated. Sick leave shall be deducted

on a prorata amount equal to the percentage of salary paid by the district.
