IB School Site Councils

A site council shall be established in each building in the district.

Each council shall be responsible for providing advice and counsel for

evaluating state, school district, and school site performance goals and objec-

tives and in recommending methods which may be employed at the school site

to meet these goals and objectives.

The membership of each council shall include, at a minimum, the building

principal, and representatives of: teachers and other school personnel, parents

of pupils attending the school, the business community, and community leaders.

Each principal shall submit, for the board's consideration, names of in-

dividuals to be considered for appointment to the site council. The board shall

of Education evaluating the effectiveness of each school site council. Reports
