ID Instructional Program (See BBG, CJ, CL, IC and IJ)

All certified shall cooperatively develop an integrated, comprehensive,

performance-oriented preK-12 Instructional Program, which will be composed of the

specific course and programs offered that allow students to meet the goals and objectives

set forth in the educational program. The instructional program is to include district

instructional goals and learning objectives and be based on valid educational research and

current State Board of Education requirements. After board of education approval,

district instructional goals and learning objectives shall be used by the staff as the basis

for developing and implementing specific curricula. The superintendent shall develop a

schedule for periodic curriculum reviews.

Modification

Additions, deletions or alterations to the Instructional Program shall be approved

by the board.

Personnel

Outside resources and district personnel may be used in curriculum development.

Financial Resources

The board encourages the superintendent to secure federal, state and private

grants, or other alternative funding sources for use in curriculum development. The

certified staff is encouraged to use available commercial, public domain and community

resources to assist in developing the instructional program and extending it beyond the

traditional classroom setting.
