Any punishment, suspension or expulsion, may be deferred by the prin-

cipal (add other positions as appropriate). The student involved may be placed

on probation for a set period of time. The punishment, suspension or expul-

sion, shall remain deferred so long as the student meets the conditions of the

probation. If a student is placed on probation, written notification shall be

sent to the student's parent or guardian. Any decisions on probation for stu-

dents found to be in violation shall be handled by the superintendent.
