### NOTICE OF BOARD WORKSHOP MEETING OF THE TYLER INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT BOARD OF TRUSTEES

Notice is hereby given that on Thursday, December 7, 2017, the Board of Trustees of the Tyler Independent School District will hold a Board Workshop meeting at 11:00 AM at the Tyler ISD Administration Building, Conference Room B, 1319 Earl Campbell Parkway, Tyler, TX. The subjects to be discussed are listed on the agenda which is attached to and made a part of this Notice.

#### Texas Government Code Section:

551.071	Private consultation with the board's attorney.
551.072	Discussing purchase, exchange, lease, or value of real property.
551.073	Discussing negotiated contracts for prospective gifts or donations.
551.074	Discussing personnel or to hear complaints against personnel.
551.076	Considering the deployment, specific occasions for, or implementation of, security personnel or devices.
551.082	Considering discipline of a public school child, or complaint or charge against personnel.
551.083	Considering the standards, guidelines, terms, or conditions the board will follow, or will instruct its representatives to follow, in consultation with representatives of employee groups.
551.084	Excluding witnesses from a hearing.

Should any final action, final decision, or final vote be required in the opinion of the School Board with regard to any matter considered in such closed or executive meeting, then the final action, final decision, or final vote shall be either:

- (a) in the open meeting covered by the Notice upon the reconvening of the public meeting; or
- (b) at a subsequent public meeting of the School Board upon notice thereof; as the School Board shall determine.

Subject: 2016-2017 Texas Academic Performance Report

#### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

The Texas Academic Performance Reports (TAPR) combine details of district and campus academic performance with financial reports and information about staff, programs, and demographics.

#### ADMINISTRATIVE CONSIDERATION

Texas Education Code Chapter 39 requires each district's board of trustees to publish an annual report that includes the Texas Academic Performance Report (TAPR), campus performance objectives.

The TAPR report is available on the internet at the Texas Education Agency website.

The TAPR and other required reports are also available under Education Reports on the school district's website. http://www.tylerisd.org

A hearing for public discussion of this report must be held within 90 days of receipt of the TAPR report. The hearing may be combined with a regularly scheduled meeting of the local board of trustees, but must be held at a reasonable time, when parents and taxpayers can attend. Within two weeks after the hearing the report must be widely disseminated within the district.

Lone Star Governance Goal 2 – College & Career Readiness Lone Star Governance Goal 3 – CTE Coherent Sequence

#### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

Lone Star Governance Goals 2 and 3, established during the 2016-17 school year, focus on college and career readiness, advanced course completion, and CTE coherent sequence of courses, as defined by the Texas Education Agency.

**Lone Star Governance Goal 2 -** The percentage of graduates who are considered college and career ready will increase by an average of at least 4% annually over the next five years (from 55.8% in the spring of 2016 to 75.8% in spring of 2021).

- Baseline (spring 2016) 55.8% (Class of 2015)
- Year 1 Target (spring 2017) 59.8% (Class of 2016)

Lone Star Governance Goal 2 (Progress Measure 2) - The percentage of District students completing two or more advanced/dual credit courses will increase by an average of at least 3% annually over the next five years (from 38.8% in the spring of 2016 to 53.8% in spring of 2021).

- Baseline (spring 2016) 38.8%
- Year 1 Target (spring 2017) 41.8%

**Lone Star Governance Goal 3 -** The percentage of graduates completing a CTE coherent sequence of courses will increase by an average of at least 8.5% annually over the next five years (from 29.4% in spring 2016 to 71.9% in the spring of 2021).

- Baseline (spring 2016) 29.4% (Class of 2015)
- Year 1 Target (spring 2017) 37.9% (Class of 2016)

#### ADMINISTRATIVE CONSIDERATION

The previously established goals and progress measures are based on data provided in the annual Texas Academic Performance Report (TAPR), which is finalized and reported during the fall semester of each school year. Based on the final 2016-2017 TAPR, Tyler ISD graduates exceeded the targets in all three areas: Goal 2 (+7.6%), Progress Measure 2.2 (+1.7%), and Goal 3 (+1.4%).






