<p>Classroom Experience</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Classes will be conducted as normally as possible. ● Teachers will provide in-person instruction daily. ● Teachers will follow the district curriculum. ● Students will enhance learning through digital content. ● As part of the blended model of instruction, online resources will be available for students to access at school, or at home, using Lincoln Learning or Google Classroom, to supplement classroom instruction and should there be a break in traditional learning. 	<p>Classroom Experience</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Daily lessons provided by Lincoln Learning and supplemented by PGJHS teachers in order to coordinate with on-site students. ● Conferences are scheduled by students and/or teachers based on need. ● Teachers will communicate virtual meeting times with students. ● Teachers regularly check grades and communicate with students and parents. ● Teachers regularly assess student learning. ● The Lincoln Learning lessons will have as close as possible to the same sequence as those students who are at school physically.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Teachers will check grades regularly and communicate with parents and students. • Students will transition to virtual learning as required by the school district, DESE, ADH, or CDC. • Social distancing will be practiced, when possible. • Wear a face-covering or mask as required by school policy and wear when asked and/or needed. 	<p>Some online lessons could be supplemented by classroom teachers.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students may have the opportunity to attend synchronous and asynchronous lessons based on teacher discretion. • Teachers and students will check grades regularly and communicate with parents and students. • Some classes will use Google Classroom rather than Lincoln Learning if those classes are unavailable on the Lincoln Learning LMS. • <i>Unlike the end of the 2019-2020 school year, the assignments will be new concepts and topics for the appropriate grade level and based on Arkansas State Standards. The assignments will be graded for completion and accuracy.</i>
<p>Student Expectations</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attend school daily. • Follow social distancing guidelines to the best of your ability. • Work in large and small groups. • Participate in blended learning. • Complete assignments and assessments when due, which can be part of the student's grade. • If schools are closed, students in grades 7-8 will use Buzz by Lincoln Learning except for those classes that are not offered by Lincoln Learning (Honors and AP courses for example). If the class isn't available on Lincoln Learning then Google Classroom will be used. 	<p>Student Expectations</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attendance <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Attendance will be taken based on student interaction and completion of assignments, and lessons will be graded as required. ○ Attend virtual learning daily • Conferences <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Students must have access to the internet. ○ Remain in contact with your teachers and attend Google Meetings with teachers when requested. ○ Communicate with teachers about their learning. ○ Schedule 1:1 virtual conferences with teachers by appointment.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Wear a face-covering or mask as required by school policy and wear when asked and/or needed. ● Try to limit social interaction through ADH guidelines. ● Students must carry their own supplies and keep up with their backpacks and individual chromebooks each day. ● Frequent hand sanitizing. Clean each time you enter and leave the room. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Check email daily. ● Content and Assignments <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Access content through Google Classroom or Lincoln Learning. Your teacher will guide you through that process. ○ Learning will be documented through various online tools. ○ Students may be required to work in small groups through Google Meet and other online tools. ○ Students are responsible for completing assignments and assessments in a timely manner, which will factor into the student's grade. ● Bring a face-covering or mask as required by school policy and wear when asked when on campus.
<p>Parent Expectations</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Communicate with teachers ● Monitor student's progress and grades through HAC. ● Make sure your student stays home when not feeling well. ● No visitors allowed in the building. ● Support district/teacher mask policy/recommendations 	<p>Parent Expectations</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● <i>While teachers will be available online at certain times during the regular school day to assist students at home, parents need to know that students in a virtual setting will not get the exact same instruction as those at school.</i> ● Ensure students are participating in online learning. ● Communicate with teachers. ● Monitor student's progress/grade through the HAC system and/or Lincoln Learning (BUZZ) program. ● Provide multiple means of communication to include an email address as most apps and tools will have the option to invite parents. ● Create a schedule with your

<p>Curriculum</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Curriculum is created and presented by PGJHS certified teachers. ● Lincoln Learning assignments may be used in some cases. ● Core content areas: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ English ○ Math ○ Science ○ Social Studies ● Honors English, US History, Algebra, and Physical Science ● Extracurricular ● Encore Courses ● Onsite Arkansas Athletic Association (AAA) activities 	<p>Curriculum</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Curriculum is created by Lincoln Learning, but monitored and sequenced by PGJHS certified teachers. ● Other supplemental material may be used to mirror onsite learning. ● PGJHS certified teachers will monitor progress and grades and assign or reassign lessons as needed for the student to be proficient. ● Students will work at their own pace, with recommendation of 3-4 hours daily of school work but will need to meet assignment deadlines. ● Core content areas: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ English ○ Math ○ Science ○ Social Studies ● Honors English, US History, Algebra, and Physical Science ● Virtual Extracurricular (Student Council, clubs, etc.) ● Encore Courses ● Onsite Arkansas Athletic Association (AAA) activities ● <i>Some virtual honors, elective, and encore courses may not be available.</i>

<p>Health</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Frequent sanitation of surfaces and buildings • Social distancing when possible • Students and staff stay home when not feeling well and/or have been exposed to COVID-19. • ADH guidelines will be followed for students and staff who test positive for COVID-19. • If necessary, contact tracing will be conducted by the Arkansas Department of Health. • No sharing of school supplies.
