Cleaning, Sanitizing, Disinfecting and Ventilation 7/20/2020

Cleaning, Sanitizing, and Disinfecting

The procedures will be the same, but the timing of the process will need to be adjusted based on the school schedule in place.

A deep clean will be conducted when students are not in the building. High traffic areas including, but not limited to, hallways and bathrooms will be cleaned throughout the day with a focus on high touch surfaces.

Excess furniture and other items will be removed from the classrooms to provide additional spacing for social distancing. Recommendation for removal or alternative solution for shared items such as classroom libraries. Water fountains will be shut off or provide limited access.

Classrooms have hand sanitizer stations in them and will be provided a bucket of disinfecting wipes to be used in the classrooms during the day and between class changes. Signage to also be provided.

The cleaning materials used by the District are listed on the CDC approved cleaning guidance.

Cleaning of District vans will be conducted daily by maintenance staff. Outsourced transportation cleaning will be the responsibility of the third party vendor.

Ventilation

Filters have been changed over the summer and will be done again in the winter. The HVAC system is operational and includes air exchange from outside dampers. Windows should be kept closed to allow the system to operate effectively.
