## Guidelines for Health office

\*All students/staff are required to wear a mask upon entering the nurse's office.

\*Thermoscan thermometers will be set up to scan students upon entering the nursing office. If temperature is detected, the student will be directed to an isolation room.

\*ALL STUDENTS who come to the nursing office will be assessed for symptoms of COVID-19 (follow checklist) whether flagged with a temperature or not.

\*If a student answers yes to 2 or more questions on the checklist the parent will be notified and the student will be sent home with a letter and return to school physician signature sheet.

\*Contact other buildings if siblings attend and assess for symptoms of illness. Follow the same guidelines as above.

\*NO student will be allowed to return to school until physician has signed off on their return and the nurse has possession of documentation.
