

Social Distancing and Other Safety Protocols



Classroom/Learning Space

Individual student desks to be spaced six feet apart to the maximum extent possible.



Cafeteria and other congregate settings..

Alternative Settings for breakfast and lunch.



Hallways

Teach and reinforce hall expectations .



Hygiene Practices for students and Staff

Teach and reinforce hygiene practices for students and staff.

Teach and reinforce use of face coverings for students and staff.



Recess and Physical Education

Identify activities that can be conducted during physical education class that prohibit shared use of equipment.



Limiting the sharing of materials

Develop procedures for students to safely select and use independent reading books.



Posting signs that emphasize how to stop the spread of germs.

The District will purchase and place signs in the hallways, classroom and restrooms that focus on social distancing, handwashing and wearing face coverings.



Identify and restrict non-essential visitors.

Establish procedures that will limit non-essential visitors and continue to meet the needs of students, parents and staff.

Communicate new procedures with all stakeholders.



Staggering the use of communal spaces and hallways.

Develop classroom restroom schedules.



Adjusting dismissal schedules and procures to the extent possible.

Establish dismissal plans that will provide social distancing. (Locations / Schedules)

Cafeteria Considerations

Foam containers with lids to replace trays

Pre-portion fruit and vegetables in single use containers

Wrap or box main entrée at Middle / High School

Service will operate as cashless. Money can be deposited in drop boxes and will be processed at the end of the day. Families will be informed that all deposits will take 24 hours to be processed. Online pre pay services will be highly encouraged.

Scan Cards. Clean keypad after each use for 6th – 12th grade students

Grab-and-go breakfast

Cashiers will hand out condiments packets to middle / high school level. Monitors at the elementary level will use squeeze bottles and place in the student's container.
