

2020-21 Reopening Options

Option 1

Schools will reopen on a hybrid schedule. Students will be issued a district device (iPads in grades PK-2 and Dell laptops grades 3-12).

Hybrid learning: Students are divided into two groups with one group attending full day, in-person school on Mondays and Thursdays and the other group attending on Tuesdays and Fridays. The remaining three days will consist of virtual learning from home.



Newberry ONE Institute for eLearning Option 2

- Although a commitment for the entire year is strongly recommended, students must commit to at least one semester in the Newberry ONE Institute for eLearning (students may re-apply to return to their zoned school at the end of first semester and will be readmitted if space is available.
- Teachers are will be trained in online platforms and virtual instruction.
- Participating students may not necessarily be assigned teachers to from their zoned school of attendance.
- There is no guarantee that all course offerings at the zoned schools of attendance can be provided via this
 option. Students may be able to enroll in coursework not available via Newberry ONE on campus, if space allows.
- Students must have reliable Internet.
- There will be no paper packets distributed.
- Students will be issued a district device (iPads in grades PK-2 and Dell laptops grades 3-12).
- Meals will be made available for pickup.
- Students will be able to participate in any extracurricular activities offered by the district.
