8	 SCHOOL BOARD MEMBER COMMENTS Mr. Lee Stoy thanked Mrs. Frances Gould and Mrs. Mindy Stevens for their years of service to Hamilton Community Schools. Mr. Lee Stoy had some concerns of the deficit in the Cafeteria Fund that accumulates over several year then needing funds transferred from one account to another. Mrs. Brittany Taylor stated there will always be a shortage of funds in the Cafeteria account and over the next couple of years the necessary funds will be transferred by the end of June, instead of waiting several years for the deficit to grow. Mr. Cassel added that the corporation is currently finding way to decrease this deficit of funds in future years. Mr. Anthony Cassel shared that we are operating at 70-75% of our appropriation of funds leaving 25% for unexpected needs such as several lights in the main gym will need to be replaced.
