OUR PRIORITIES

- To create re-opening plans that prioritize
 - following current health guidelines
 - consistency across learning environments
 - mindfulness of our most vulnerable populations
- To invite all those impacted by our decisions to have their voice heard

DEFINITIONS

- Knights-students who choose to learn remotely using an online purchased curriculum
- Blue and Silver students-those who attend on campus for some portion of the week

KNIGHTS-PHASE 3 AND PHASE 4

- Parents may opt for their students to learn remotely, regardless of phase or documented medical condition.
- Parents are asked to make this selection during registration, which will be open online from July 31-August 7. Walk-in registration for new to district students, Pre-K, and K will be held in each building on August 6.
- Knights will use a purchased online curriculum with support from designated district personnel.
- We are currently researching Edgenuity and Edmentum.
- Once this learning model has been selected, students will remain a Knight for a full semester, renewable for another semester in January.

PHASE 3 REMOTE LEARNING 2.0

- Please note that if the district needs to return to remote learning due to orders from Governor Pritzker or an outbreak in our community or school, the student body would move to remote learning supported by Blue Ridge curriculum and staff. This would be available for Blue and Silver students; Knights will remain with their purchased online curriculum.

PHASE 4 MODEL A

- **Mondays**
 - **Blue and Silver have remote, asynchronous learning.**
 - **Students receiving special education and related services may receive supports in a variety of ways-online, in small groups, or in person.**
- **Tues and Wed**
 - **Blue attends on campus with 2:20 dismissal.**
 - **Silver has Remote Learning 2.0.**
- **Thu and Fri**
 - **Silver attends on campus with 2:20 dismissal.**
 - **Blue has Remote Learning 2.0.**
- **Tues-Fri After 2:20**
 - **Office hours for Blue/Silver students not learning on campus that day.**
 - **Sanitizing of learning spaces.**
 - **Instructional planning.**

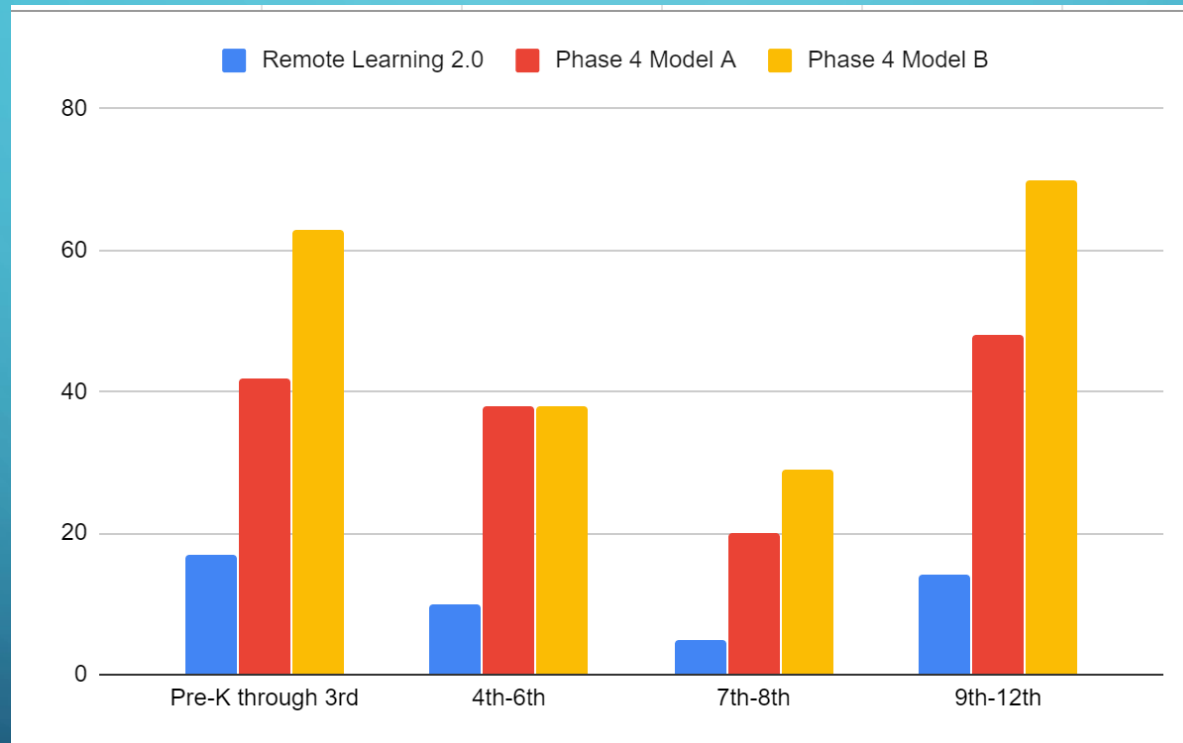
PHASE 4 MODEL B

- **Mondays**

- **Tues – Fri**
 - All K-12 students attend on campus with 2:20 dismissal.
- **Tues – Fri after 2:20**
 - Office Hours
 - Sanitizing of learning spaces
 - Instructional planning

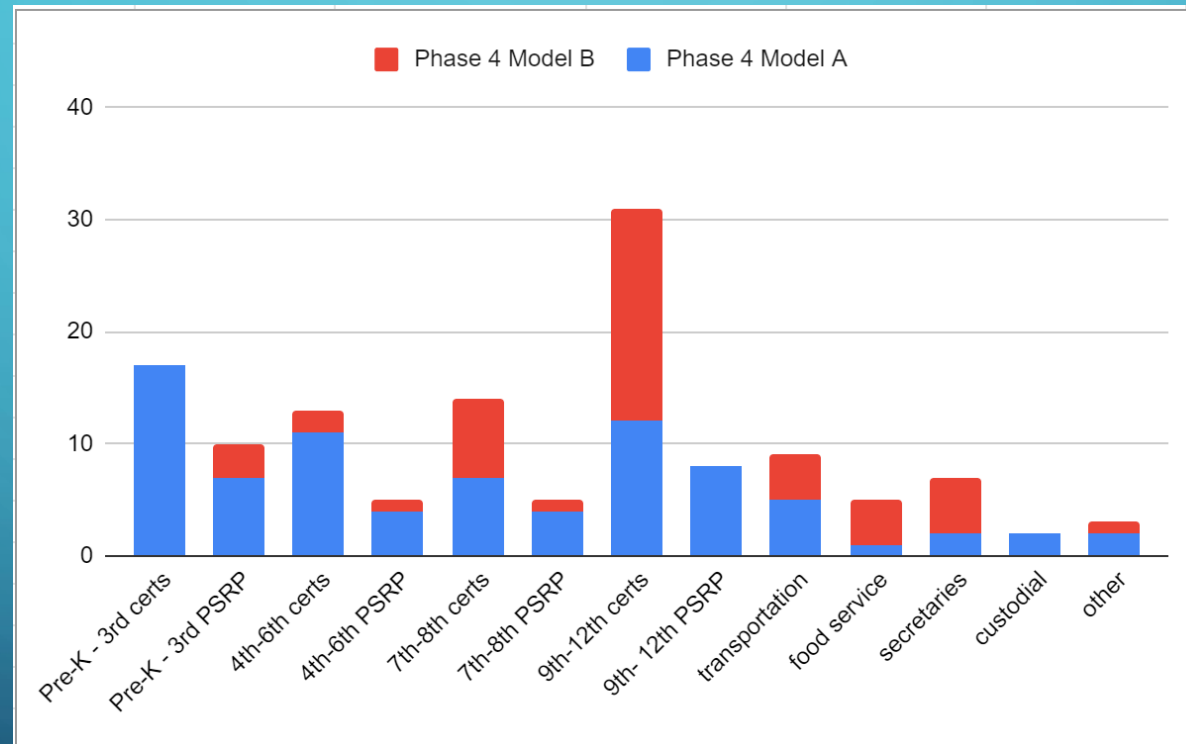
