2020-2021 Health & Safety Updates – At A Glance

- All students and staff are required to wear a mask to school but may lower their mask after being cleared to enter our facilities
- All students and staff will have their temperatures taken each morning
- Water fountains are being replaced with water bottle fill stations as soon as possible
- Cafeteria tables have been spaced to allow greater distances
- Upper grade students will eat in specific dining areas
- A gloved staff member will place milk and utensils on trays
- All classrooms will be thoroughly cleaned twice daily
- All hard surfaces on campus will be wiped down daily
- All visitors to campus must wear a mask to enter the front office
- All visitors must check their temperatures to remain on campus
- Non-Contact, Digital Forehead Thermometers will be used to gain entry into facility
- Teachers will promote thorough and proper hand washing and hygiene habits
- Classrooms are being rearranged to allow as much social distance as possible
- All unnecessary classroom items have been removed
- Playground access will be limited as much as possible
- PE will focus on individual activity that allows distancing
- Upper grade passing periods have been eliminated as much as possible
- Upper grade students will be in a self contained classroom
- Upper grade teachers will move from room to room
- Upper grade restroom breaks have been scheduled to allow small group access
- Bus windows will be down as weather permits
- All buses will be sanitized twice daily
- Masks and gloves are on site and ready for use
- Students and staff will be provided a cloth mask but students may wear their own mask if desired

Please remember this will take a cooperative effort to keep everyone safe and our school open. This is an ongoing plan with new guidance expected from the OSDE and OHD.
