

# Elmwood-Murdock Public Schools

## Daily Screening Entry Plan

1. Does student / staff have an elevated temp of 100.4F or greater?
2. Has student / staff taken any fever reducing medication in the last 24 hours?
3. Do the student / staff identify with two of the following symptoms: temp of 100.4F or higher, chills, rigors, myalgia, headache, sore throat, nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea?  
OR  
At least one of the following: new cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, loss of taste and smell.

If No ⇨ Proceed to the Classroom

If Yes



Confirm with an additional temperature check - Does the temperature read or exceed 100.4F?

If No ⇨ Proceed to the Classroom

If Yes



1. Ensure student has a mask (if tolerable) and escort them to isolation room to be sent home as soon as possible.
2. Identify and locate all household members.
3. Send student and household members home, as household members would be considered "high risk" and "in close contact".
4. Positive Test: Exclude for 10 days from symptom onset AND only allow to return 24 hours after fever resolution with no fever reducing medication, AND improved respiratory symptoms.
5. Symptomatic, Not Tested: Exclude for 10 days from symptom onset AND only allow to return 24 hours after fever resolution with no fever reducing medication, AND improved respiratory symptoms. May return to school if a medical professional establishes an alternative diagnosis, presents a doctor's note to confirm the presence of an alternative diagnosis that explains the symptoms, and meets the schools' requirements for readmission. Quarantine could be up to 14 days, or as determined by the health department.
6. Symptomatic Staff / Student Who Tests Negative: Exclude until fever free for 24 hours (or meets the schools' requirements for readmission) AND improved respiratory symptoms.
