

<u>Overview:</u> If you intend on joining or trying out for an Edgewood Athletic program this coming season, please carefully review the following information. This information applies to ALL student-athletes in a school-sponsored sport in grades 7-12.

FINAL FORMS: Please add the sport the student intends to participate in his/her Final Forms account so that coaches and administration can accurately check for medical information. Once you've added the sport, please fill out the parent forms. Also, please make sure to input an accurate student email address so the student can fill out the student forms. This must be done before the season or tryouts officially begin

Adding a Sport to a Final Forms Account

- 1. Log into Final Forms via the student or parent account. Edgewood-oh.finalforms.com
- 2. Click on the student name of the prospective student-athlete on the "**My Students**" page.
- 3. Click on the "**Profile**" button for the student you'd like to add to a roster.
- 4. Click on the "Manage Sports" button.
- 5. Click to place a **checkmark** next to the sport the student would like to join. All sports for which the student is eligible should appear in the list.

- 6. Please be sure to click all sports a student plans to join or try out for prior to the first day of official practice or tryouts. Coaches will remove students from rosters in the event that the student does not make the team or decides not to join.
- 7. OHSAA Sports Physical: All prospective student-athletes must have a valid OHSAA Sports Physical on file at the school. Please follow the instructions below to ensure that the student can participate in interscholastic athletics.
 - a. Print the following document (page 1-5) or pick up a copy in the EHS/EMS Athletic Office. A parent/guardian must fill out pages 1-3 of this document BEFORE a doctor or medical personnel can complete the physical process. https://ohsaaweb.blob.core.windows.net/files/Sports-Medicine/PPE 2020-21.pdf
 - b. Take the physical document with you to one of the following:
 - i. Primary Care Physician
 - ii. Kroger's Little Clinic- walk-in (West Side of Hamilton)
 - iii. Urgent Care- walk-in
 - iv. Primary Health Clinic at EHS-\$35.00 (Click here for flyer. You must call to schedule an appointment: 513-454-1111. No walk-ins)
 - c. Once a doctor of medical personnel completes, signs, and dates the physical on pages 3 and 4, please submit the completed physical to your son or daughter coach or the Athletic Office.
 - d. The Edgewood Athletic Secretary will log the data into FINAL FORMS, and you will be able to track expiration dates by logging into FINAL FORMS. You will receive expiration notification emails beginning at 60 days prior to expiration.

8. OHSAA PRESEASON SPORTS MEETING (please note letter C)

- a. Before each season begins, Edgewood Athletics will conduct a preseason meeting in the fall, winter, and spring. This meeting is mandated by the OHSAA.
- b. Student-athletes and parents must attend the meeting.
- c. During the 2020-2021 school year, we will NOT be having a meeting, instead, we have chosen an online format via FINAL FORMS. Each parent and student will have to watch and sign off that they have watched the PowerPoint presentation. We have chosen this method as a safety precaution to help cut down on crowds of people due to the current pandemic. The presentation will be uploaded to FINAL FORMS on August 1, 2020.
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9. Edgewood Athletics Participation Fee:

a. Students who participate in an Edgewood Athletic program must pay a participation fee for each season they play. Fees are determined based on the guidelines below:

Edgewood Athletics Participation Fee- based on the number of sports played and a family cap.

1st Sport-Fall	2nd Sport-Winter	3rd Sport-Spring
Single 3 sport athlete \$50.00	\$50.00	No charge-max \$100.00
Multi athletes (2) from the same household \$100	They both play a winter sport \$100	They both play a spring sport \$50 - family max of \$250.00

^{**} For families with multiple students who are participating in an extracurricular activity or sports the family max is \$250.00.

10. Academic Eligibility

- a. An Edgewood High School Athlete must pass 5 one-credit courses with a GPA of 1.5 and be on grade level during the previous 9-week grading period. (Physical Education does not count)
- b. Edgewood Middle School Athlete must pass 4 classes in the previous 9- week grading period.
- c. Any Edgewood Athlete taking college courses must see the Athletic Director for paperwork to have the college professors verify grades.

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^{**} Participation Fees are due before the first scheduled contest. We strongly encourage you to make your participation fee payment on FINAL FORMS.
