Minutes of the Fayetteville Board of Education

Work Session, July 16, 2020

The meeting convened at 9:15 AM via Zoom with President Nika Waitsman presiding.

Roll Call

Dr. Megan Slocum, Associate Superintendent for Support Services, presented the Phase III Parking Lot Update. Dr. Slocum recommended that the project be put on hold until more details are brought forward regarding the number of additional parking spaces that will come with the athletic projects. Dr. Slocum noted that FPS might be able to get the number of spots needed with the reconfiguration of athletic parking. Nika Waitsman, Board President, noted that the price of the project increased to 1.2M due to the requirement of a retaining wall that was not anticipated. The Board further discussed and agreed to put a hold on the project.

Dr. Slocum presented the cleaning and sanitation protocols that Fayetteville Public Schools will be following.
