

To Our GCS Families and Community:


Due to the current significant rise in COVID-19 cases and updated guidance from the Kentucky Department of Education, we believe that it is only a matter of time before school districts across the state are asked to delay the start of in-person classes. With that in mind, and to provide as much planning time for families as we can, Grayson County Schools will postpone the first day of school for all students until Monday, August 24.

At this time, we still plan to begin on the A/B schedule currently in place. Public health considerations may change those plans, and it is possible that school may need to begin on full NTI for every student.

A revised 20-21 calendar and modified A/B schedule will be released next week.

Change will be inevitable this school year. We know that makes planning a challenge. Please do your best to be prepared in advance.

We will share changes with you just as quickly as information is available to us. As we've seen during this pandemic, the notice we receive may require a very quick turnaround. We appreciate your patience and flexibility.
