

Emerson-Hubbard FBLA

On Sunday, April 10th, twenty-one members of the Emerson-Hubbard FBLA chapter left for the FBLA State Leadership Conference (SLC) in Kearney, Nebraska. Upon arrival in Kearney, the members stopped for dinner and then "The Big Apple" where members participated in a friendly game of bowling and glow-in-the-dark mini-golf.



The FBLA members then started their day bright and early Monday morning with a business tour of Icon Poly. Icon Poly is a custom 3-D fabrication business located in



Gibbon, NE. Icon Poly started as a fire hydrant replica hobby and grew into a family business with sculptures and displays spanning throughout the United States and four foreign countries. Members received a walkthrough of their full fabrication processes from start to finish and information about the custom equipment used.

State Leadership Conference officially kicked off Monday afternoon with a keynote from Brooks Harper. After the opening session, members began their competitions. The competitions throughout SLC ranged from impromptu speaking to accounting, business communications, health care administration, and agribusiness. Tuesday consisted of additional competitions, state officer voting, and the FBLA Middle-Level awards session. The high school level awards ceremony occurred Wednesday morning followed by new officer induction and closing ceremonies.

Emerson-Hubbard FBLA had multiple members who received the honor of walking across the main stage to receive their awards. The middle schoolers blew it out of the park for their first-ever FBLA



competition! Emelia Harral placed 2nd in Career Exploration and 3rd in Business Etiquette. Emily Stamm placed 1st in Exploring Technology and 5th in Financial Literacy. Jenni Olson placed 7th in Exploring Technology. The high school members had a very competitive testing experience this year as each of their tests had hundreds of participants this year. Sophomore, Codi Olson also placed at State Leadership Conference, receiving 4th place in Introduction to Parliamentary Procedure.

Emerson-Hubbard FBLA will have three students representing Nebraska FBLA at National Leadership Conference this summer. National Leadership Conference will be held in Chicago from June 28th through July 3rd. Codi Olson will be competing in Introduction to Parliamentary Procedure. Emily Stamm will be competing in Exploring Technology and Emelia Harral will be competing in Career Exploration. We look forward to future activities, conferences, and competitions in the years to come.
