Join Prenatal to 5 Fiscal Strategies (P5FS) for a discussion to provide input on the cost of child care in Nebraska, sharing your experience as a provider delivering early care and education services. The input session will focus on provider experiences with program operations and expenses to inform the child care cost model that P5FS is developing for Nebraska. The model will be used to better understand the true cost of providing high-quality child care for all children and families in Nebraska. The sessions are intended for center directors, financial managers, and family child

care provider/owners. Several sessions will be offered in Spanish.


