I am happy to let you know that on Monday evening July 20, 2020 our Board of Education approved a reopening plan for our schools for the 2020-2021 school year. An overview and highlights of this plan is contained in this attachment:

I want to offer my sincerest thanks to you for your patience, flexibility and support over the past few months as this plan was developed. It was a collaborative process involving many voices. These are very challenging times and we recognize the positives and negatives of any reopening plan--right now, there is no "ideal" plan.

Looking ahead, we only have about four weeks until school starts. During this time, I encourage you to check email often, as updates will start coming to you more frequently about the start of school under the reopening plan. In addition, we look to all of our families as partners in going back to school--we need parents to discuss important parts of this plan with our students, such as wearing a mask (required for everyone when inside our buildings) and social distancing to the greatest extent possible. More information will be forthcoming about these and other topics related to reopening.
