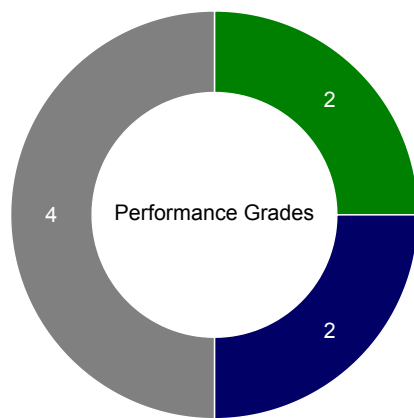

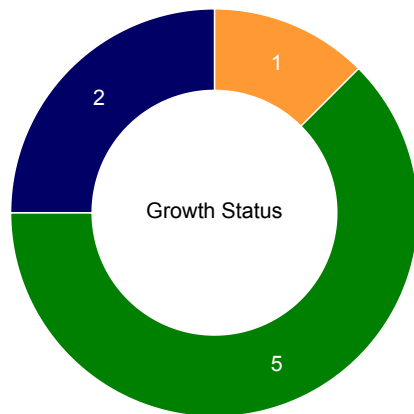

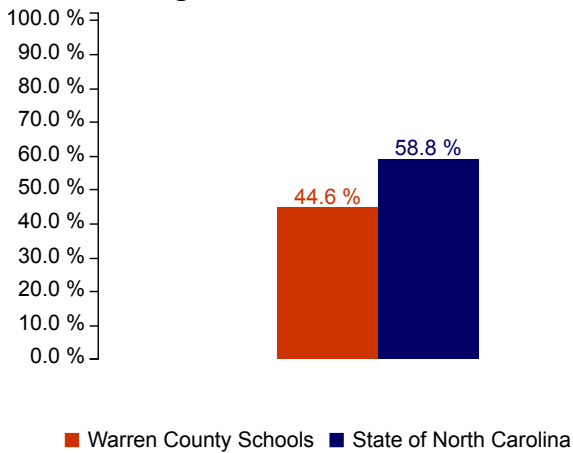

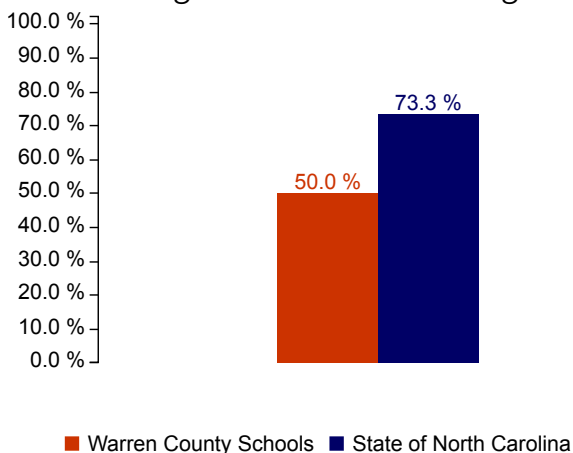
Percent Scoring 17 or above at



By School/District/State | By Subgroup

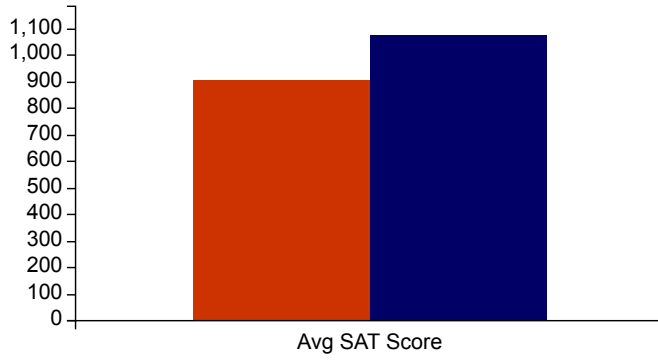

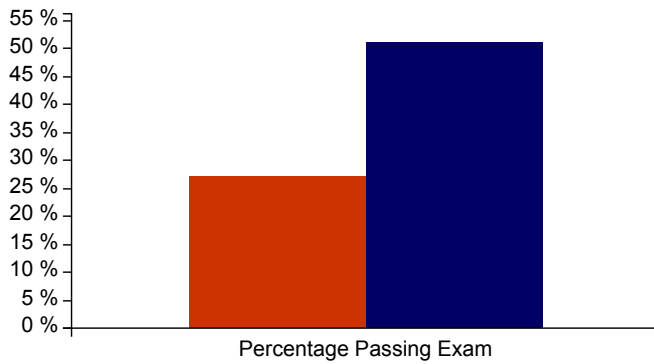

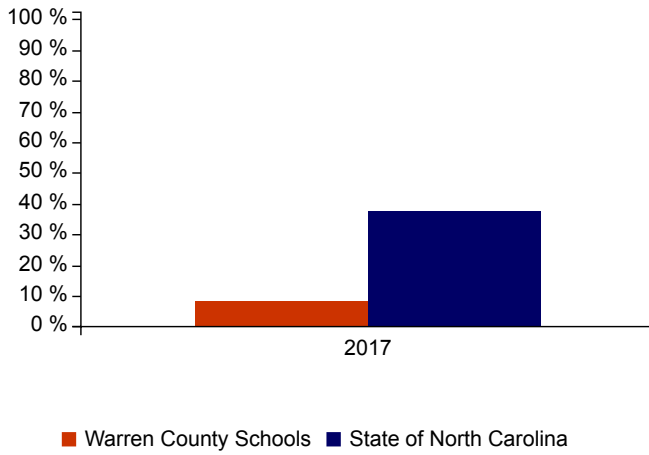

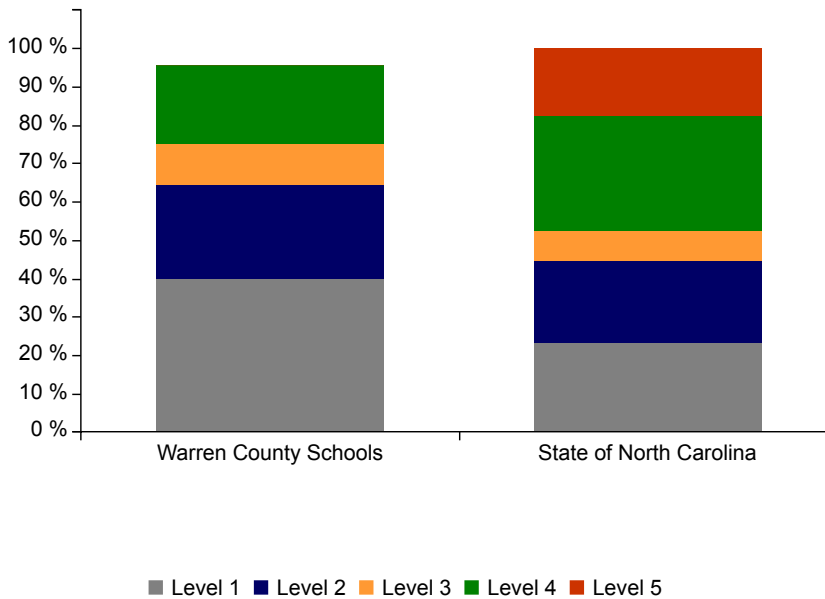

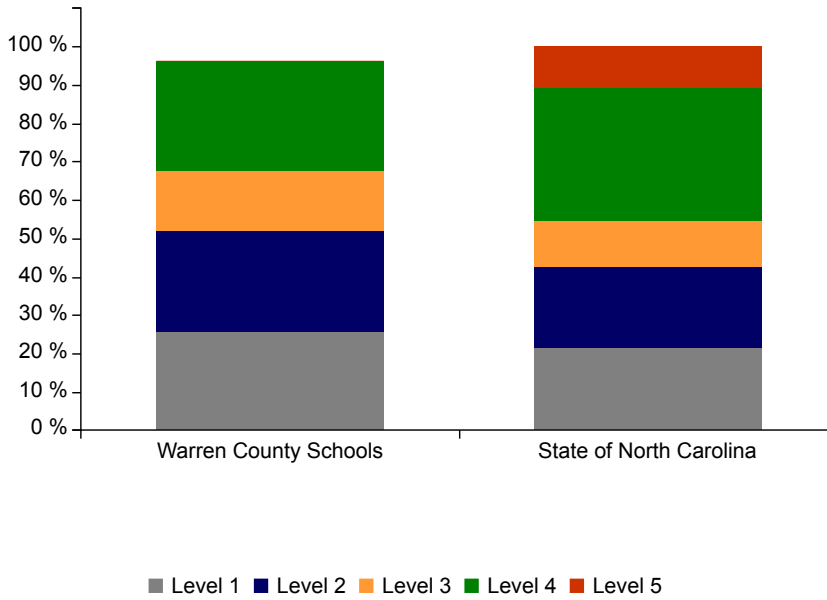

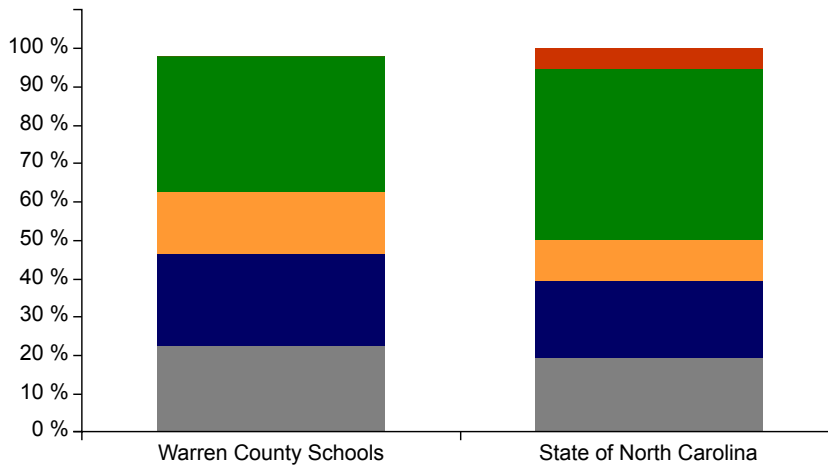

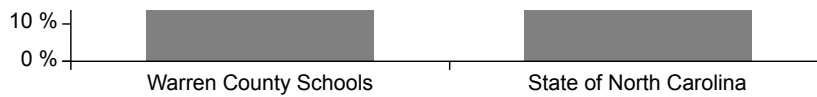

NC Math 1 Performance i





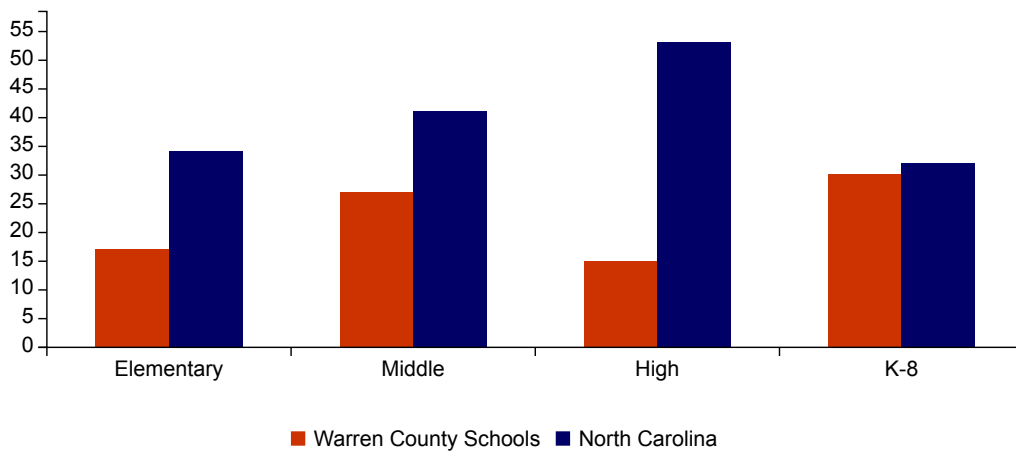

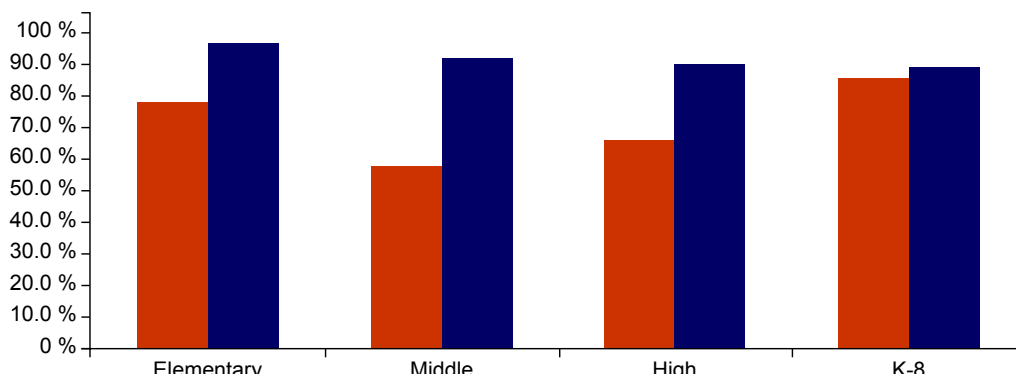

Average Number of Teachers i

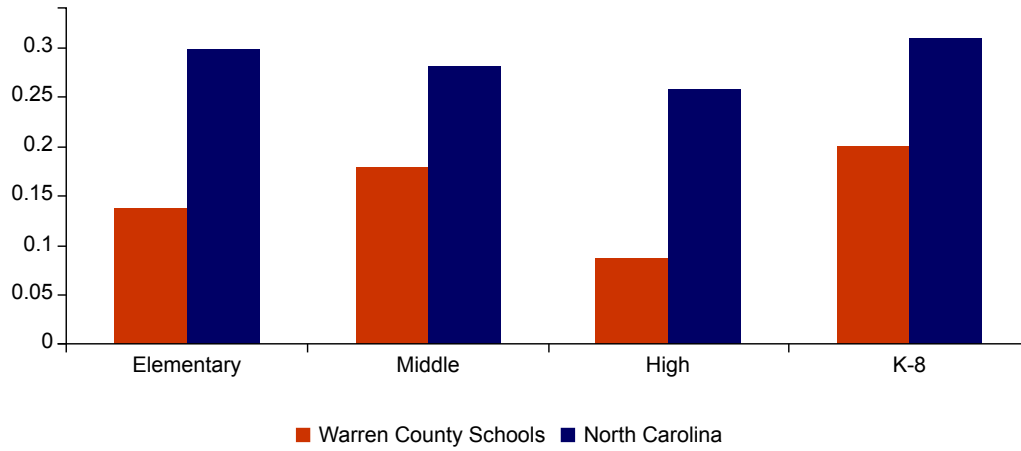


Fully Licensed Teachers Percent i

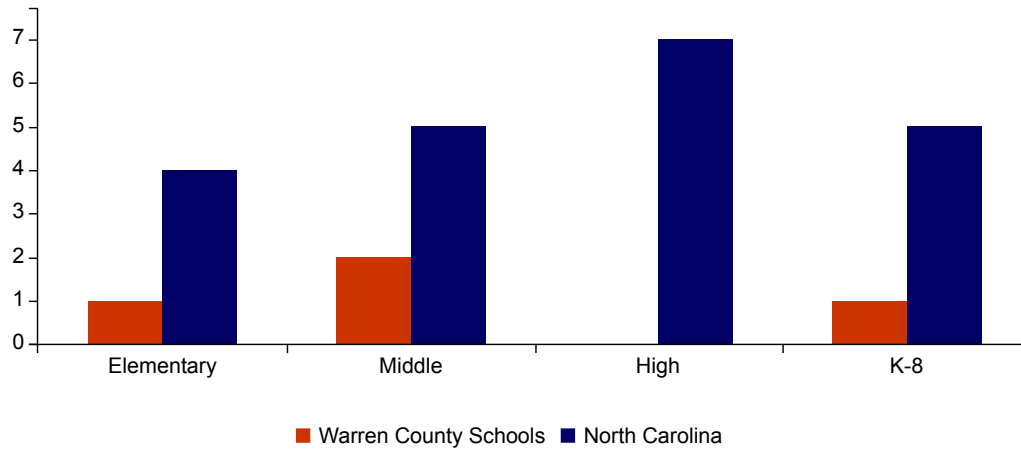

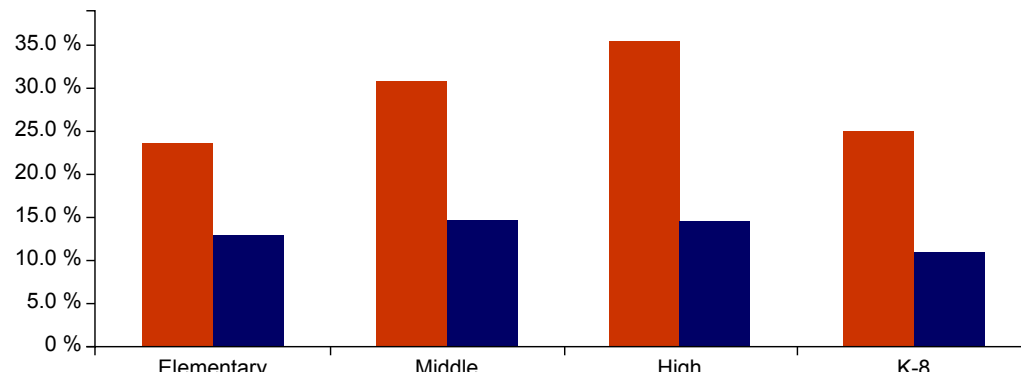
Teachers with Advanced Degrees i



Nationally Board Certified Average per School i

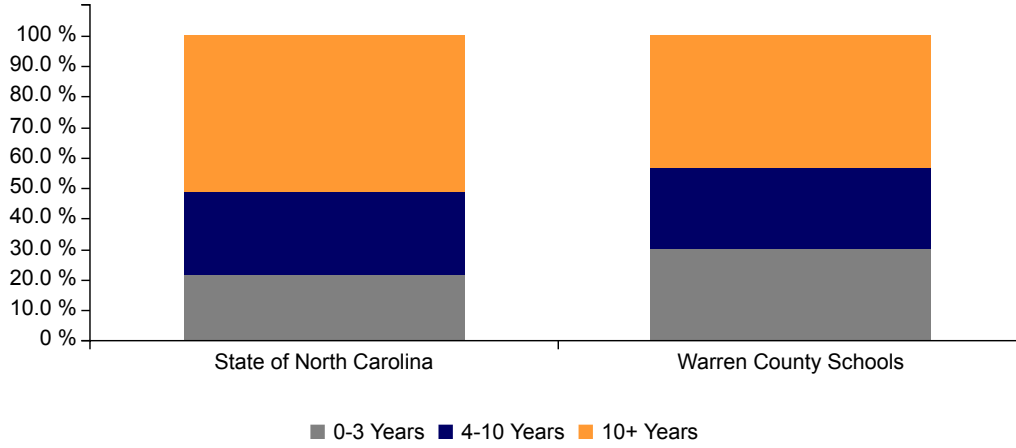


One Year Teacher Turnover Rate i

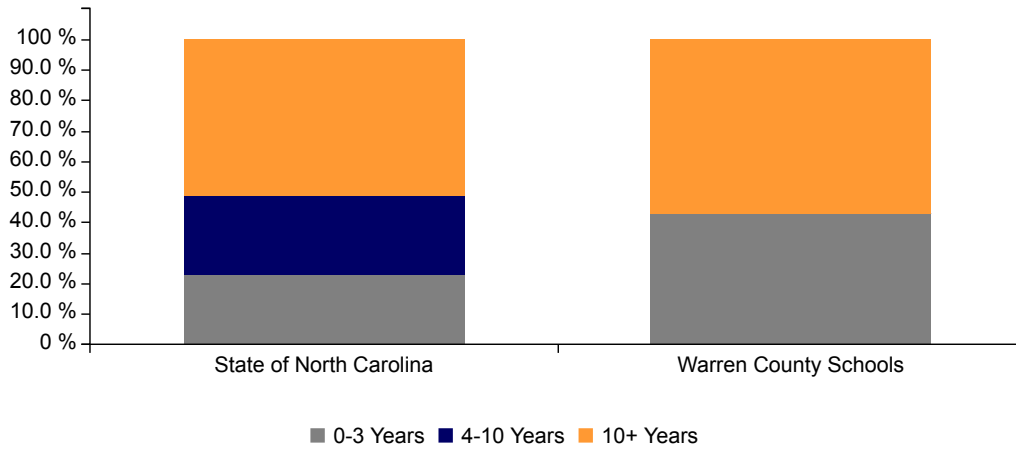

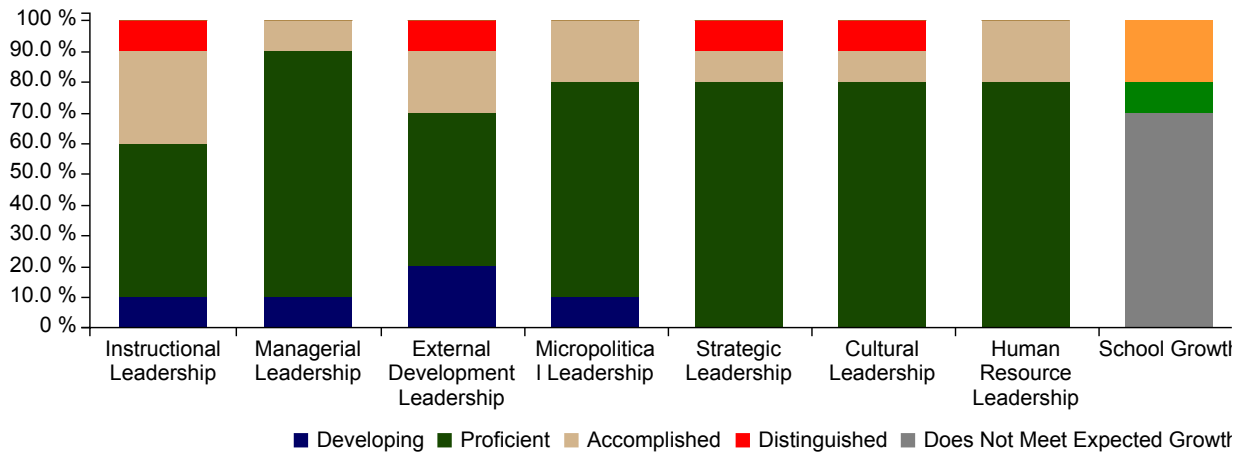

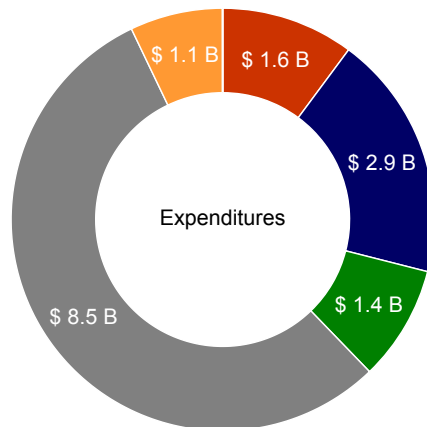
