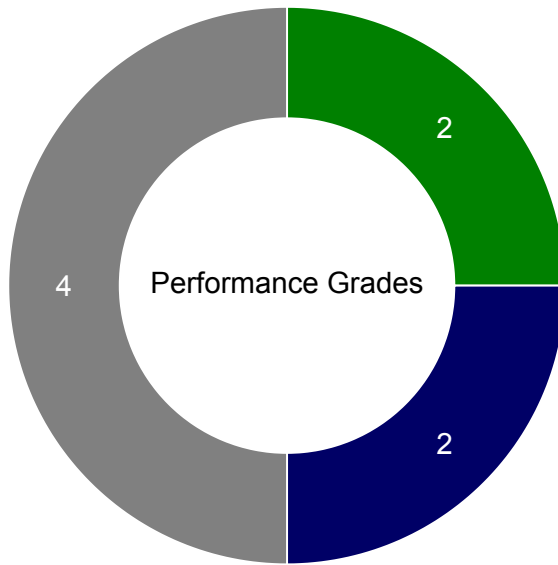

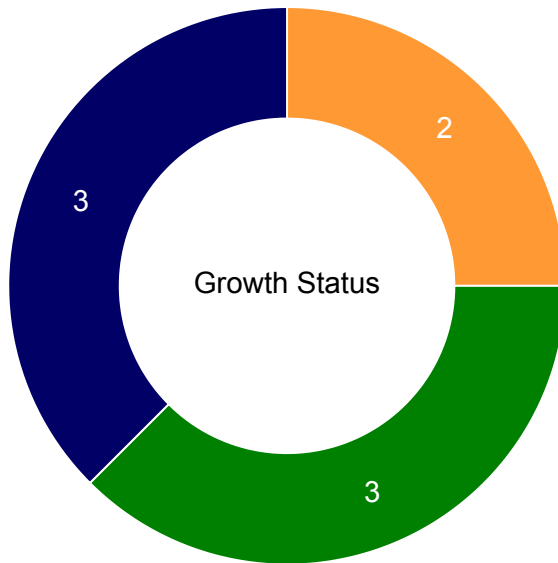

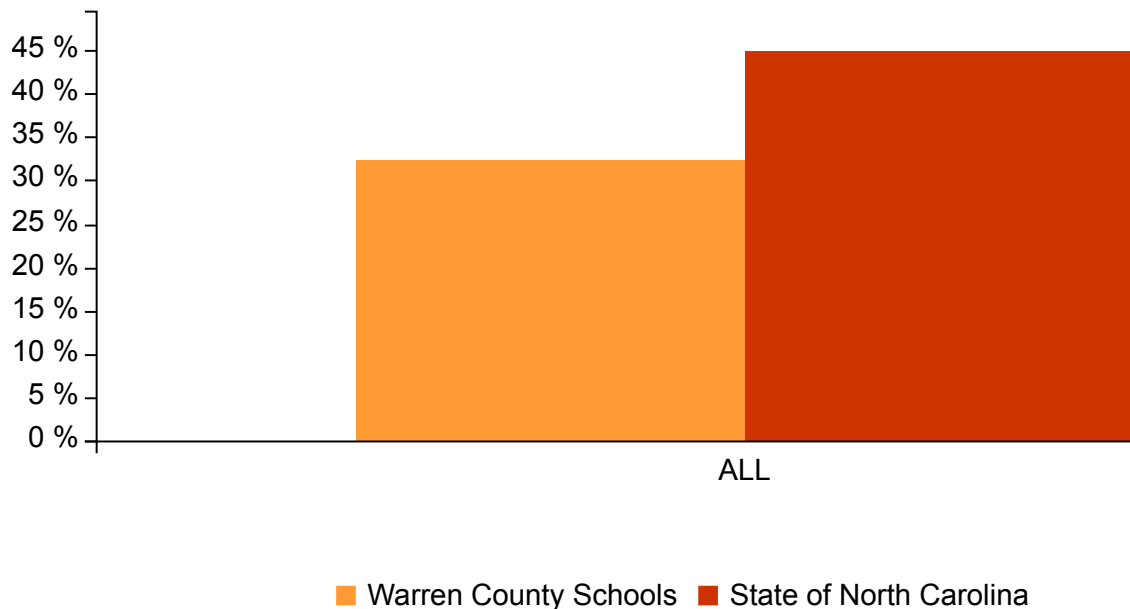

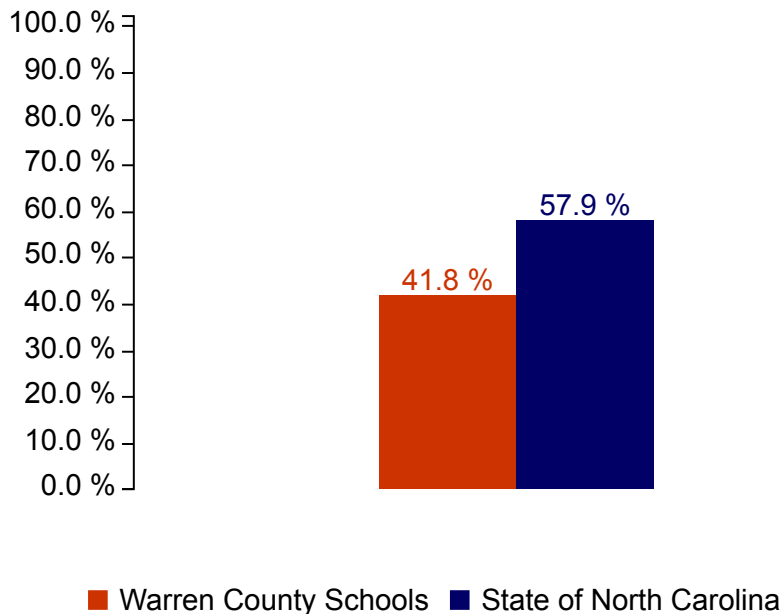

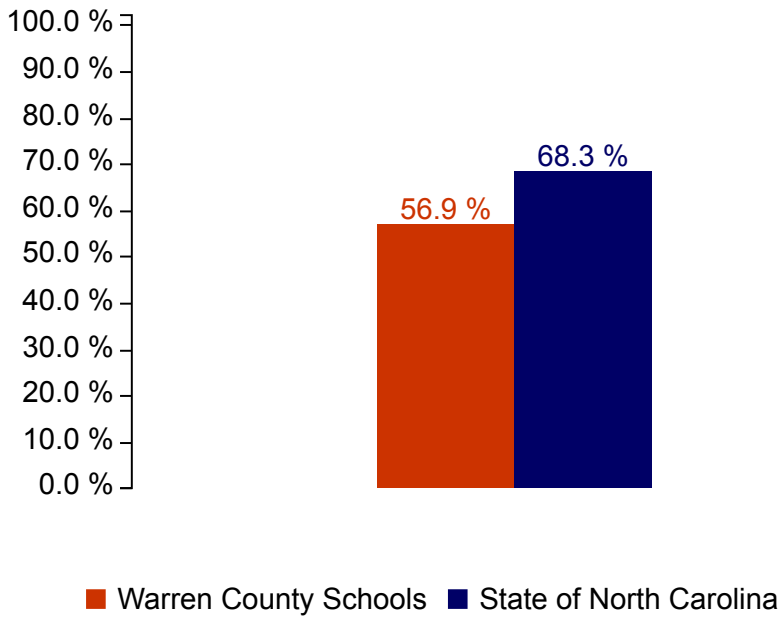
Percent Scoring 17 or above at

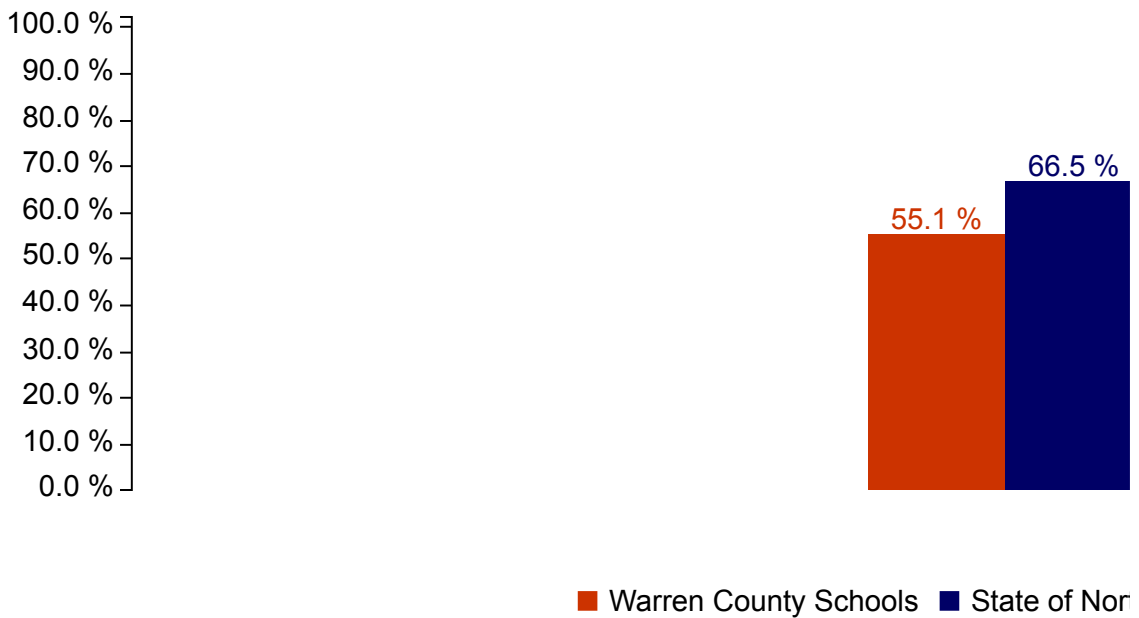

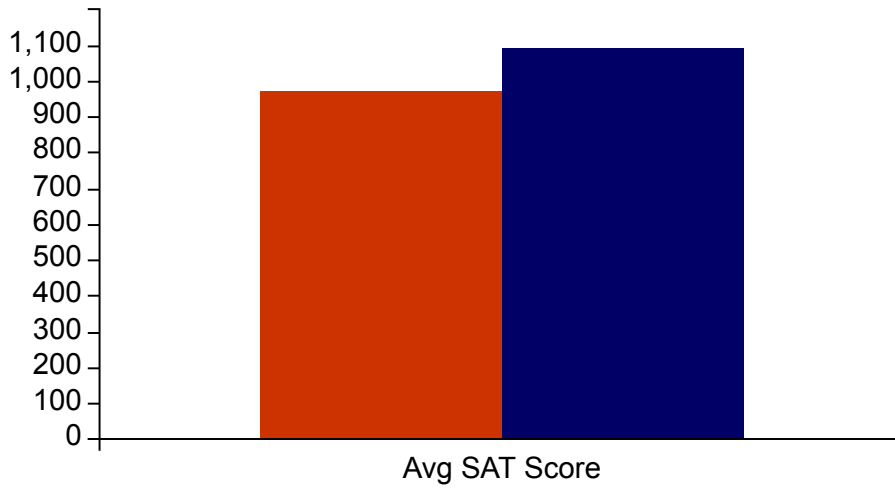

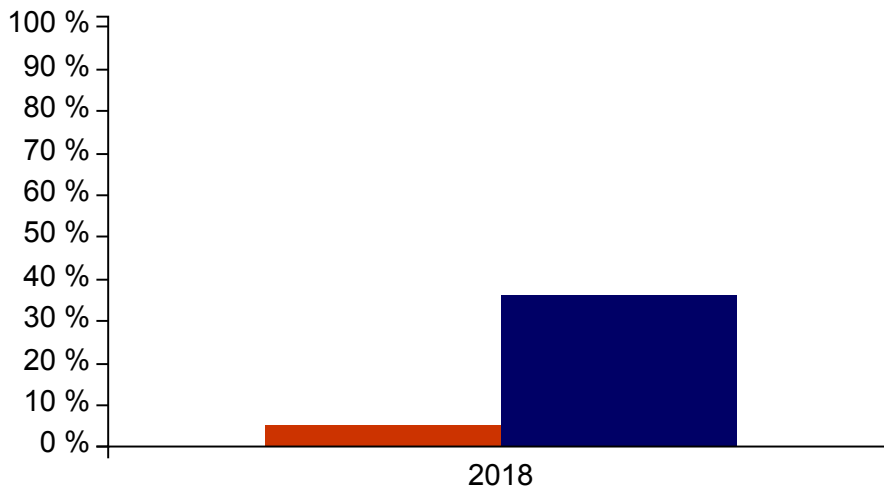

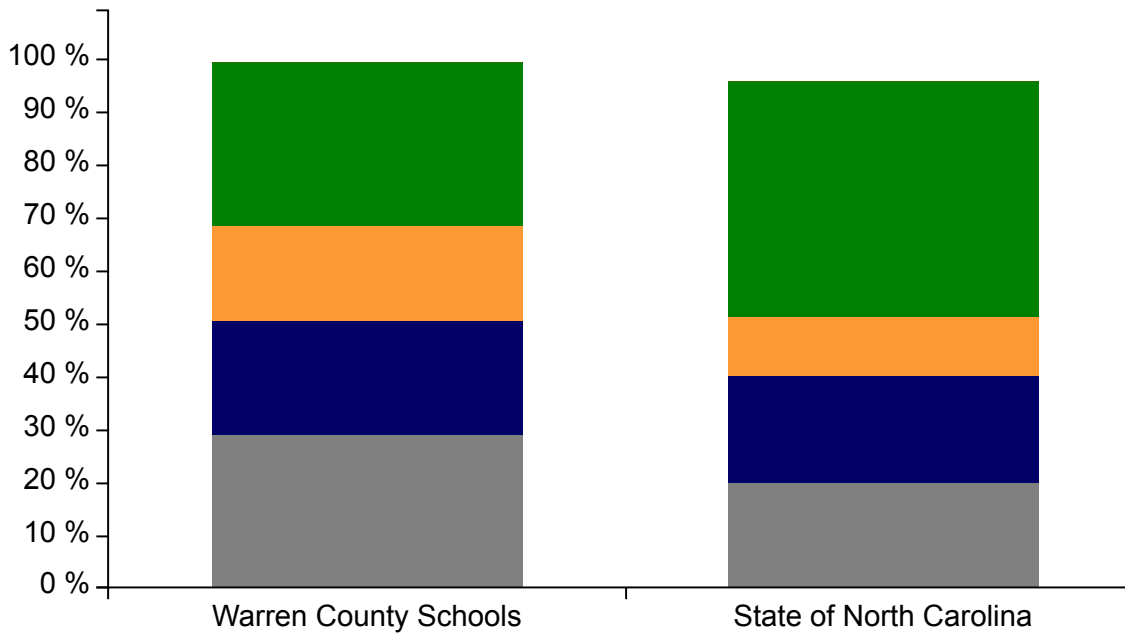
Biology Performance

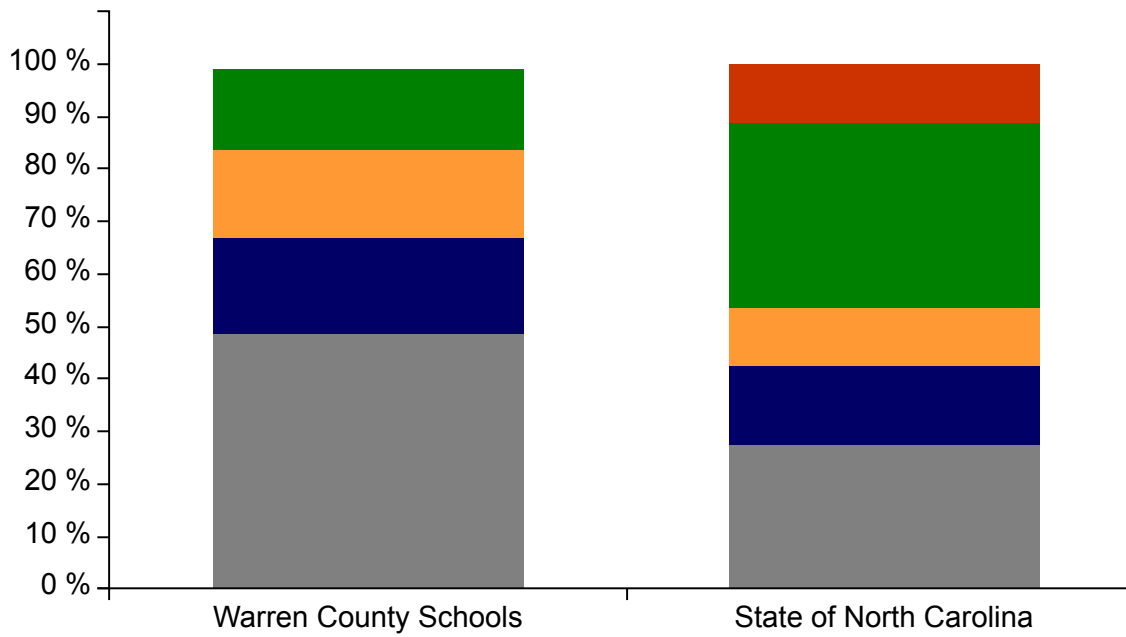
English II Performance

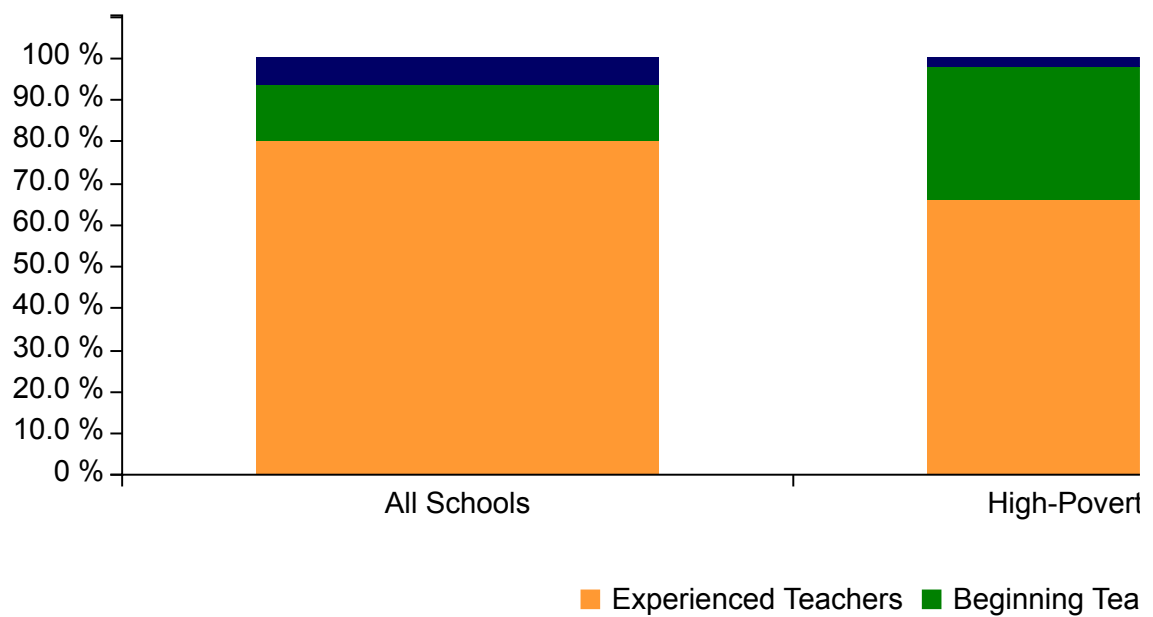

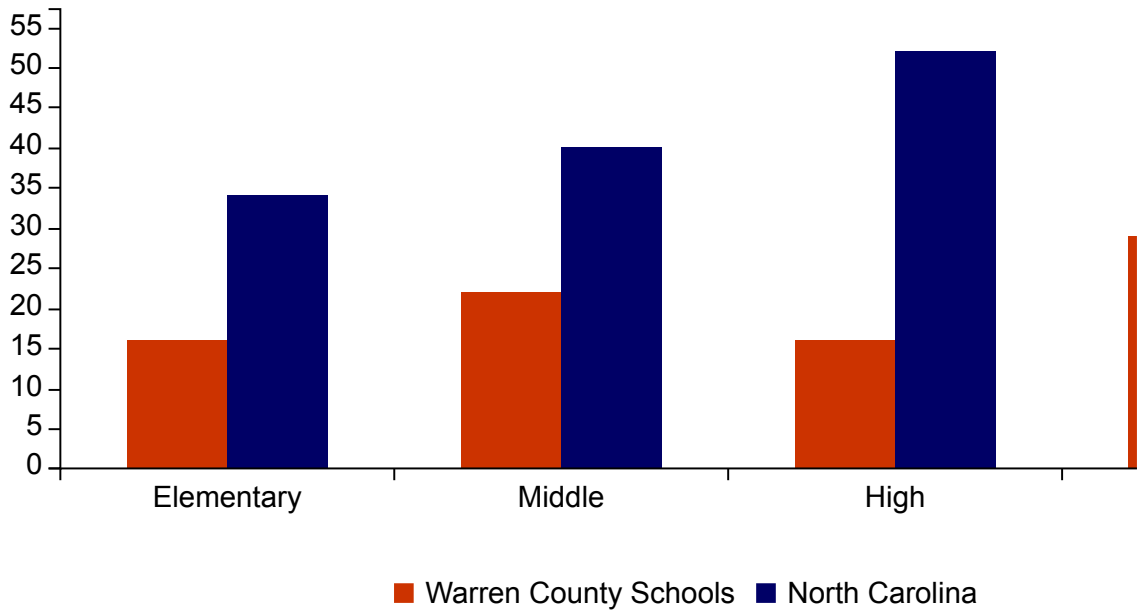

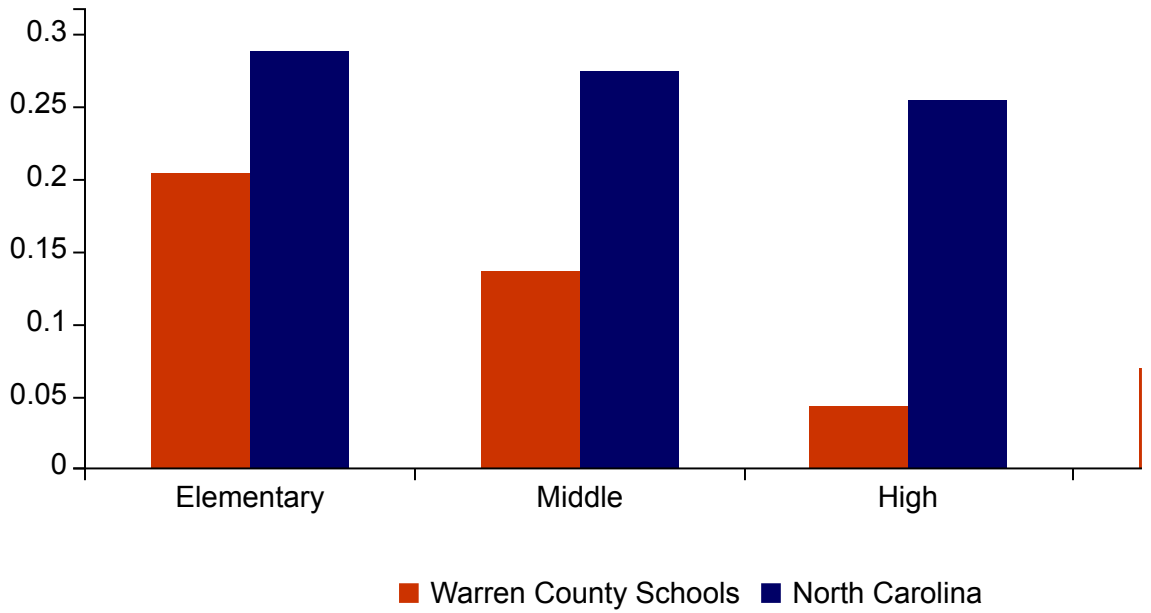
Average Number of Teachers



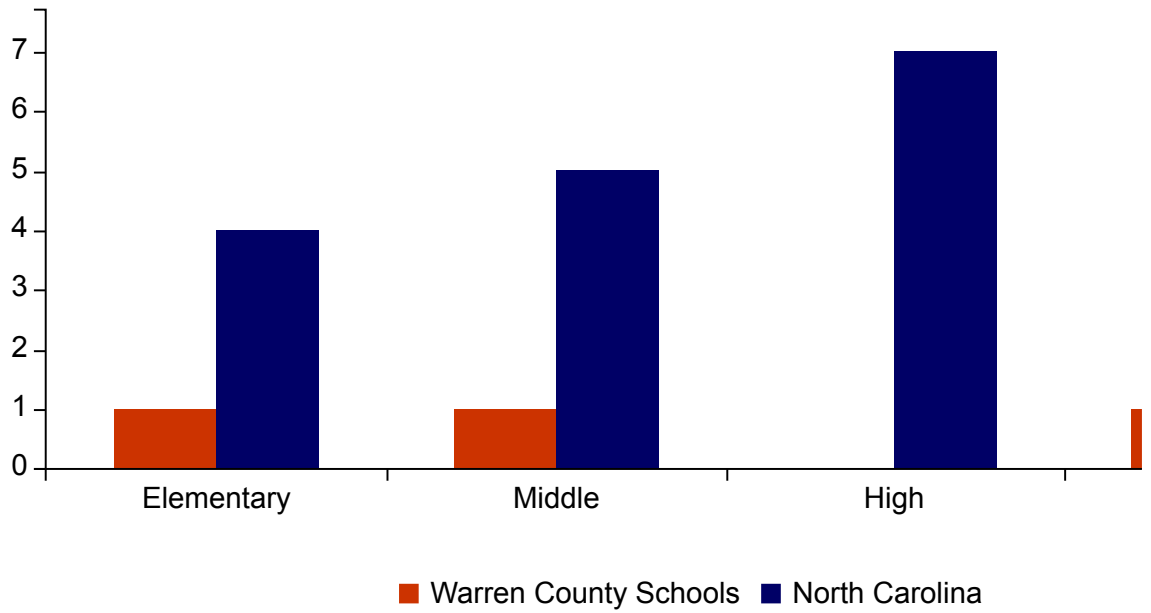
Fully Licensed Teachers Percent i



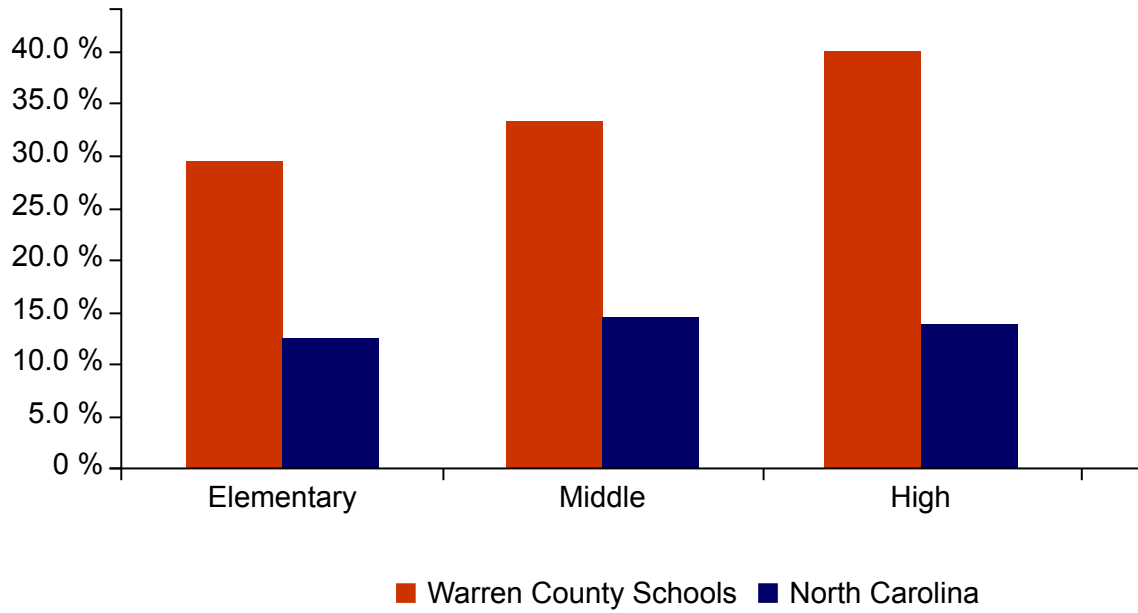

Principal Demographics



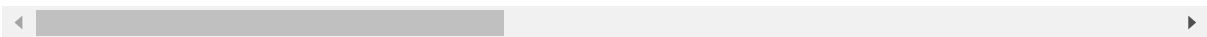
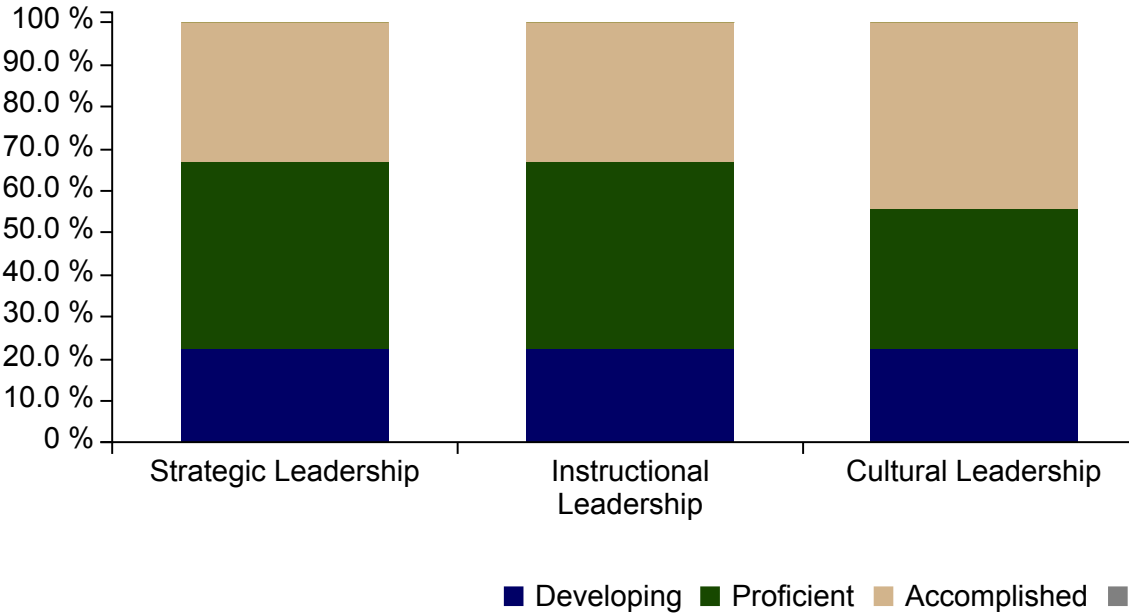

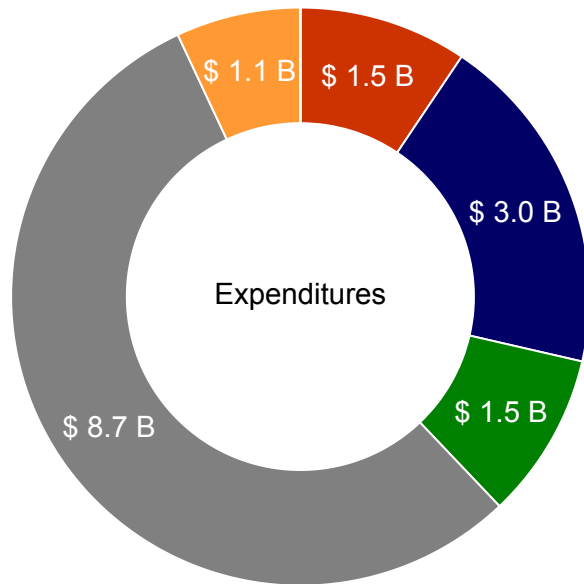
