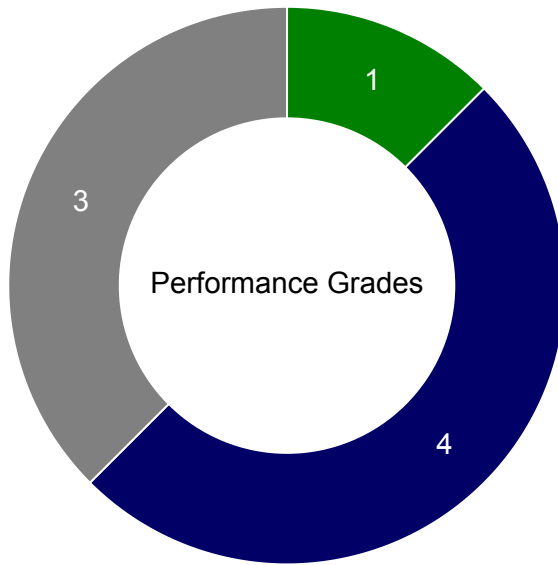

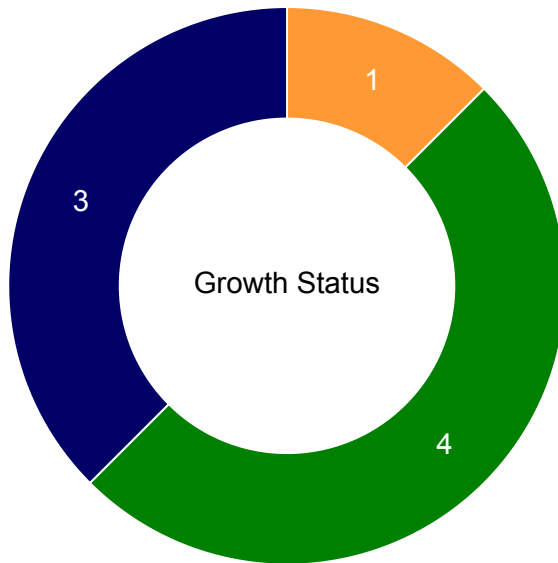

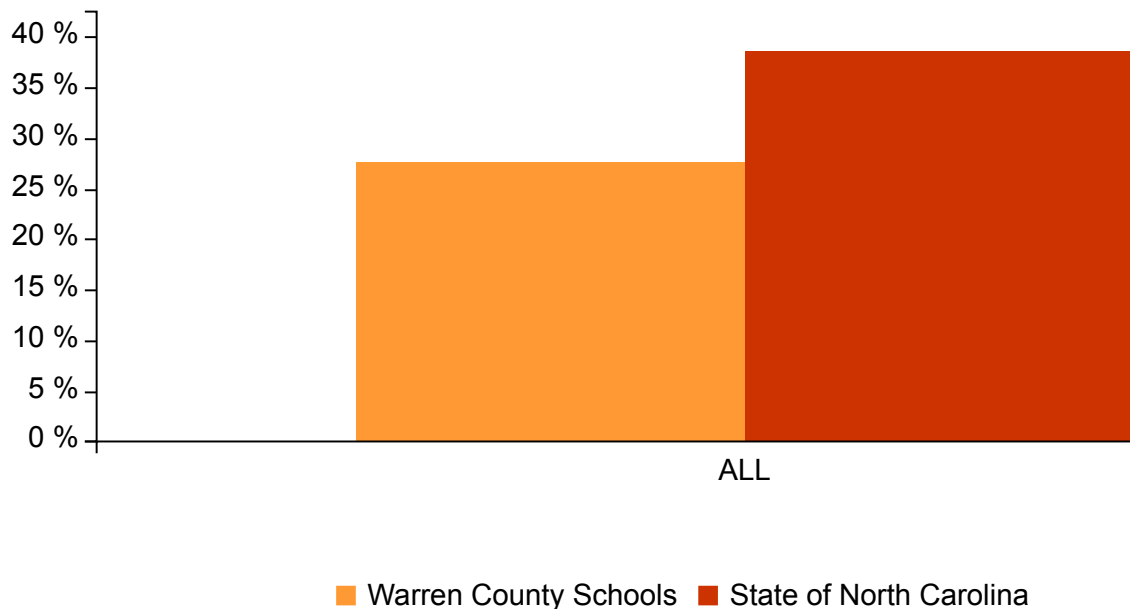

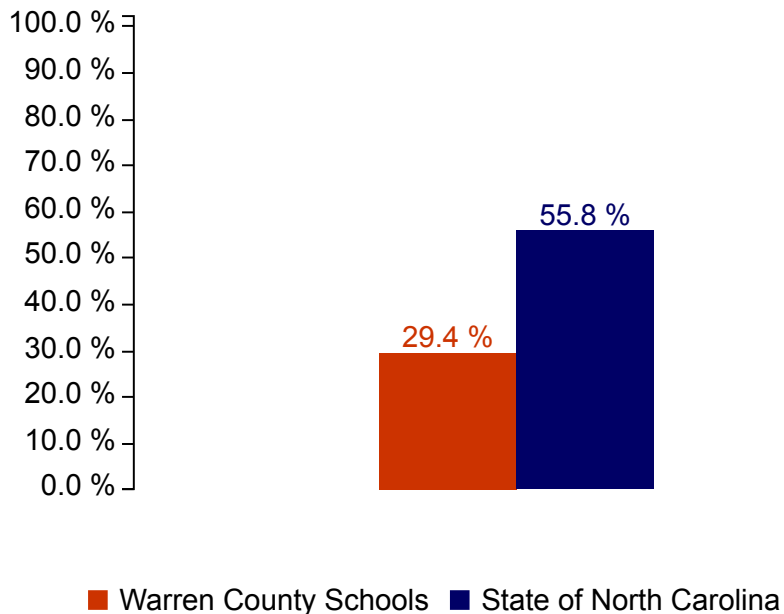

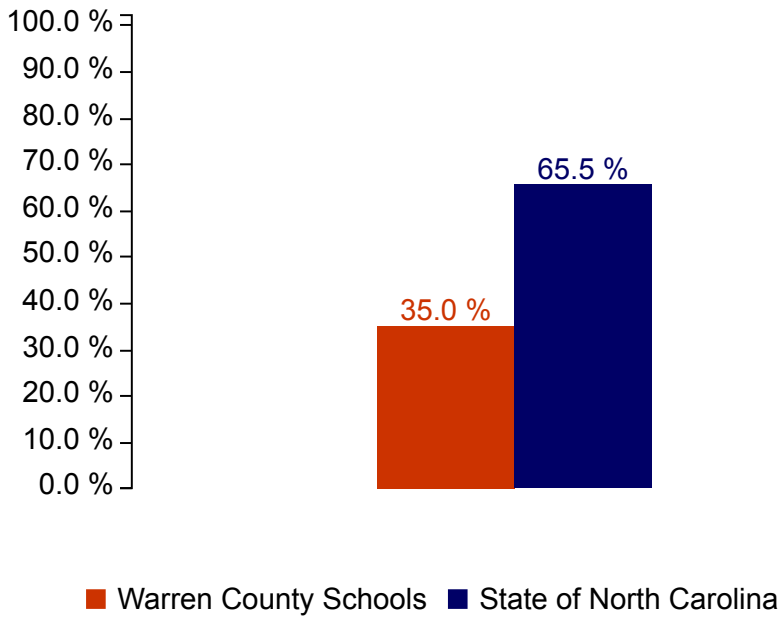
Percent Scoring 17 or above at

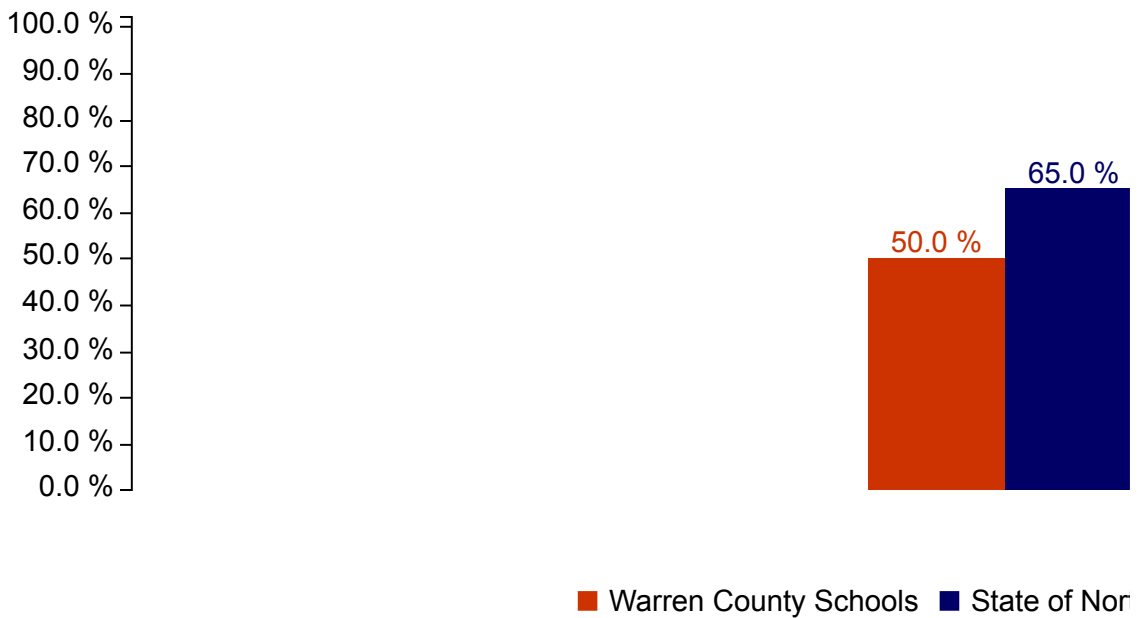
Percent earning a Silver certificate or higher at



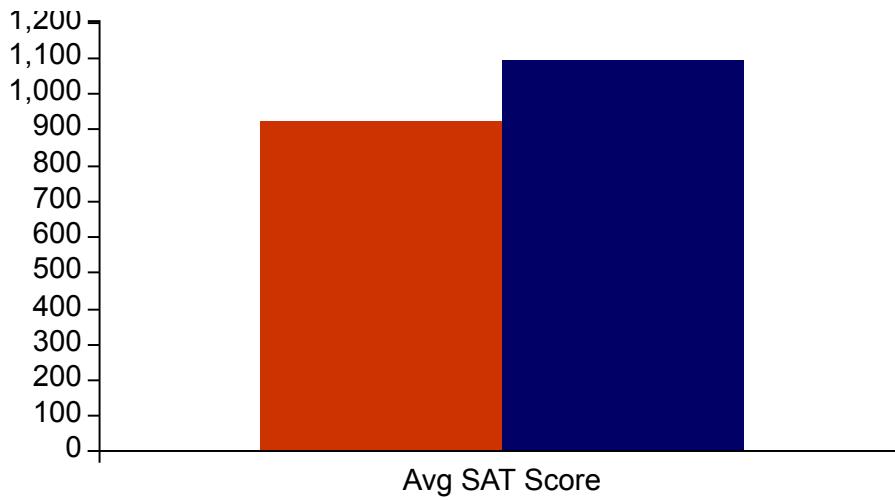

The percentage of 12th grade students who were awarded at least a Silver Level Career Readiness Certificate or scoring 17 or above at



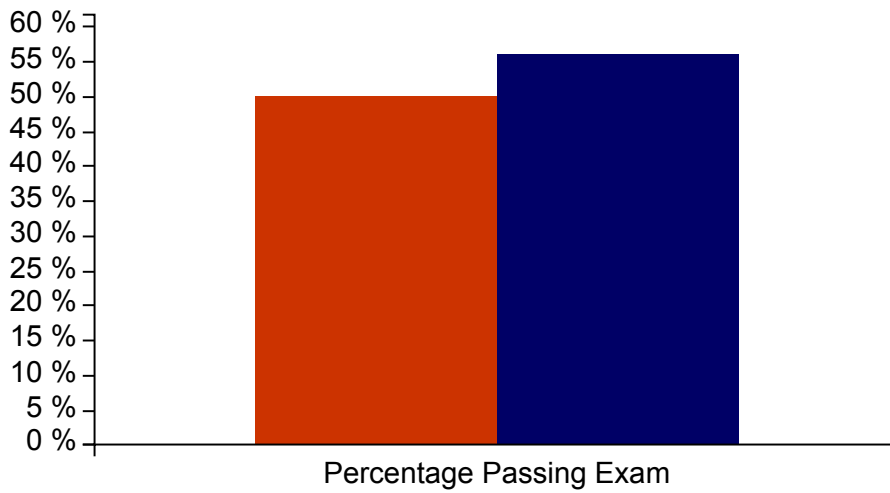

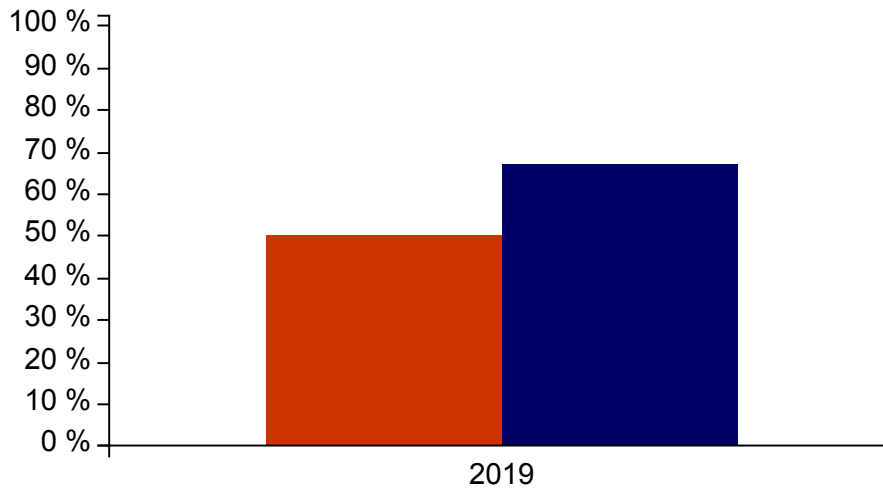

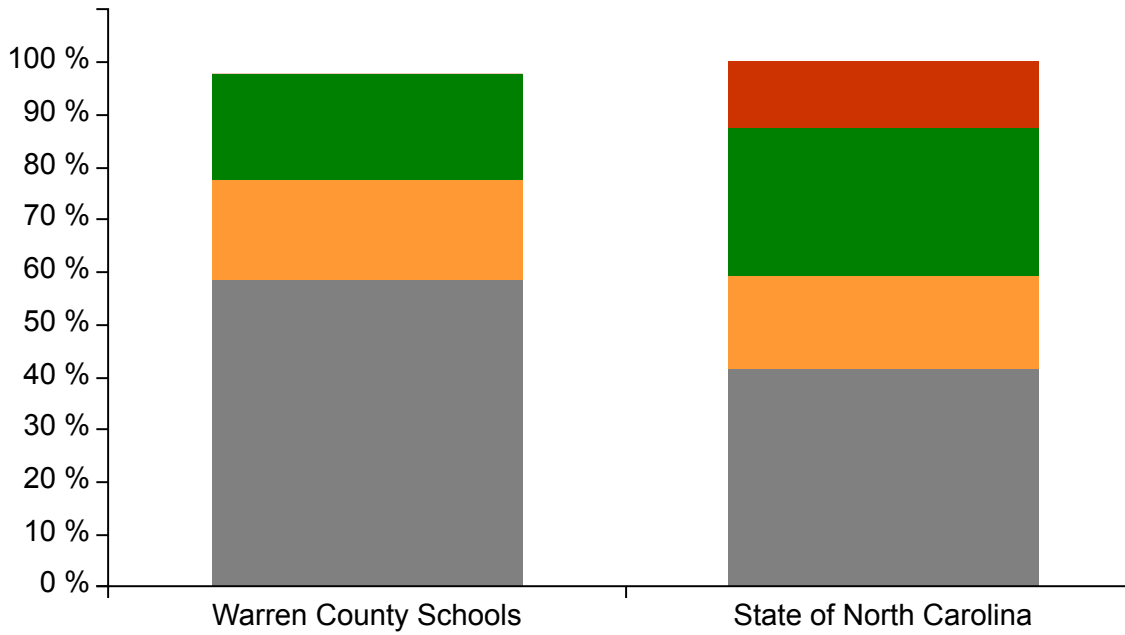

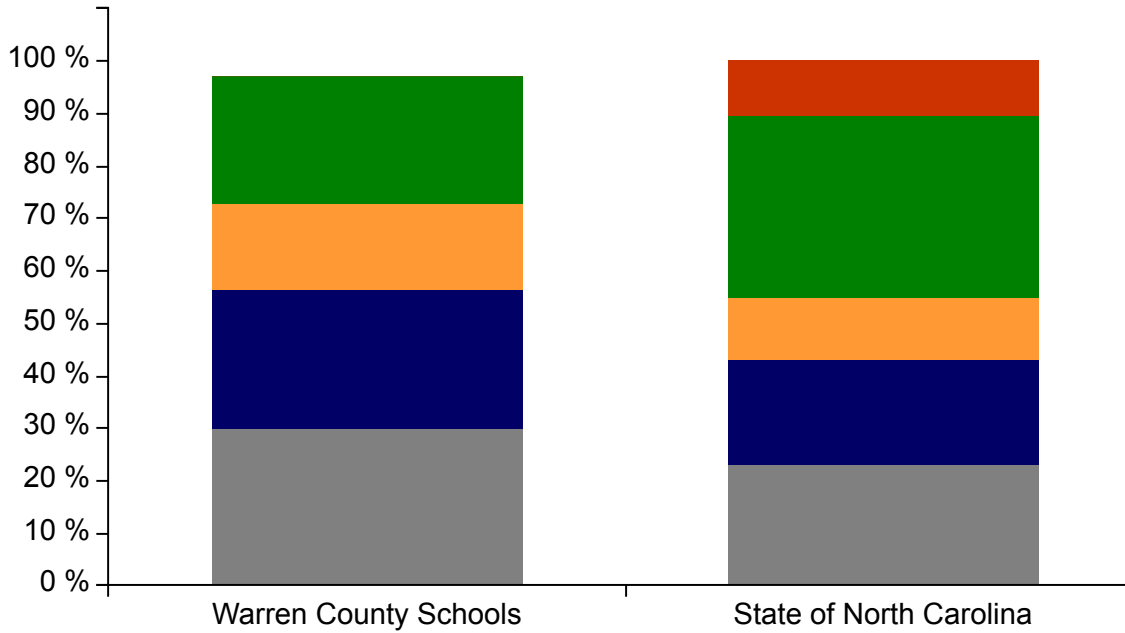

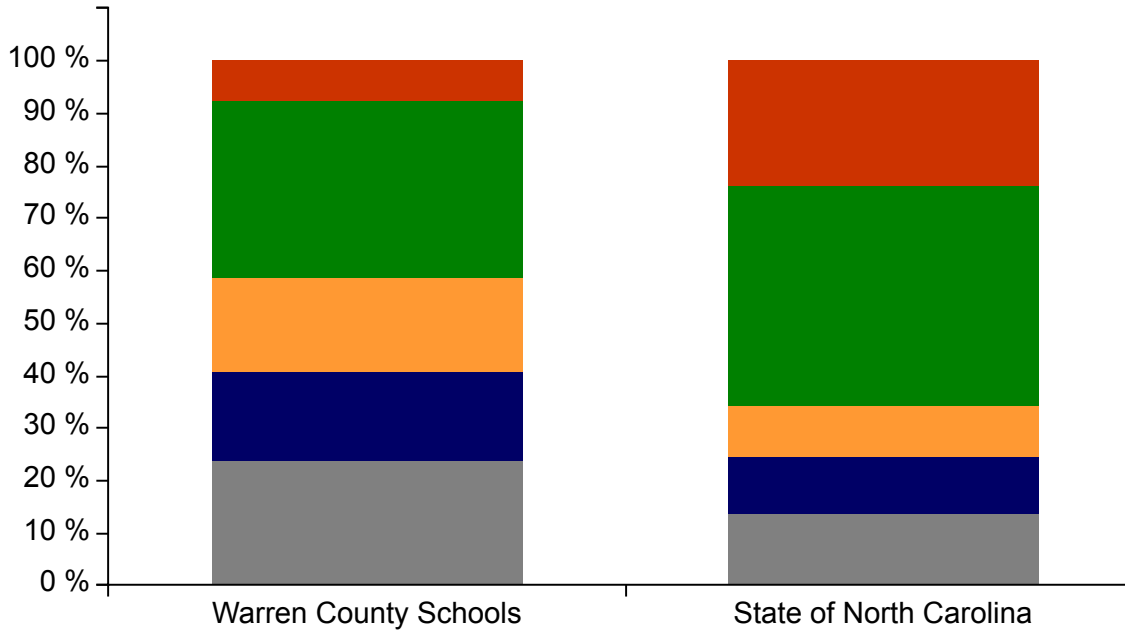

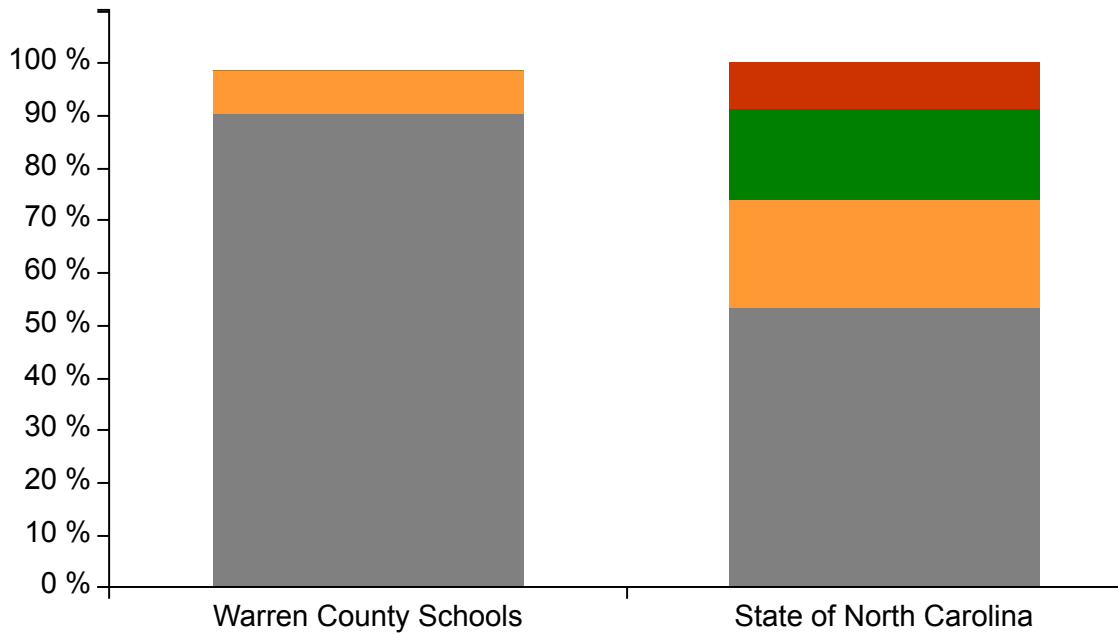
NC Math 1 Performance

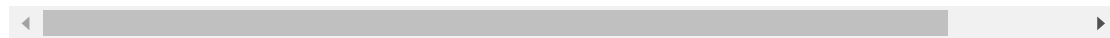

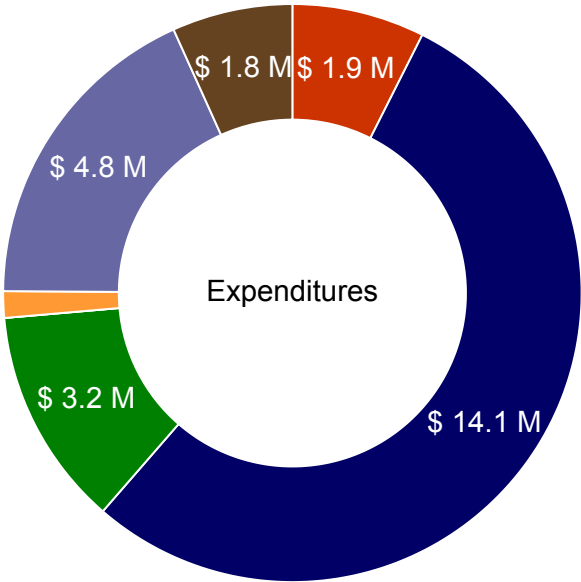
