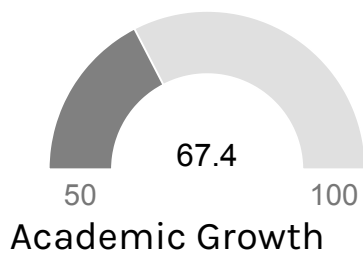

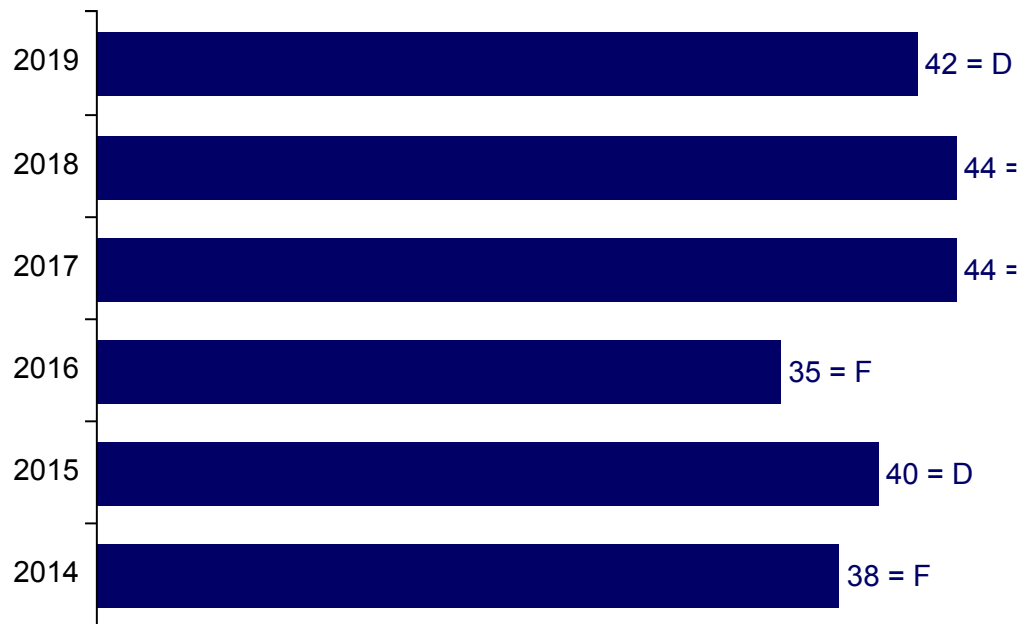

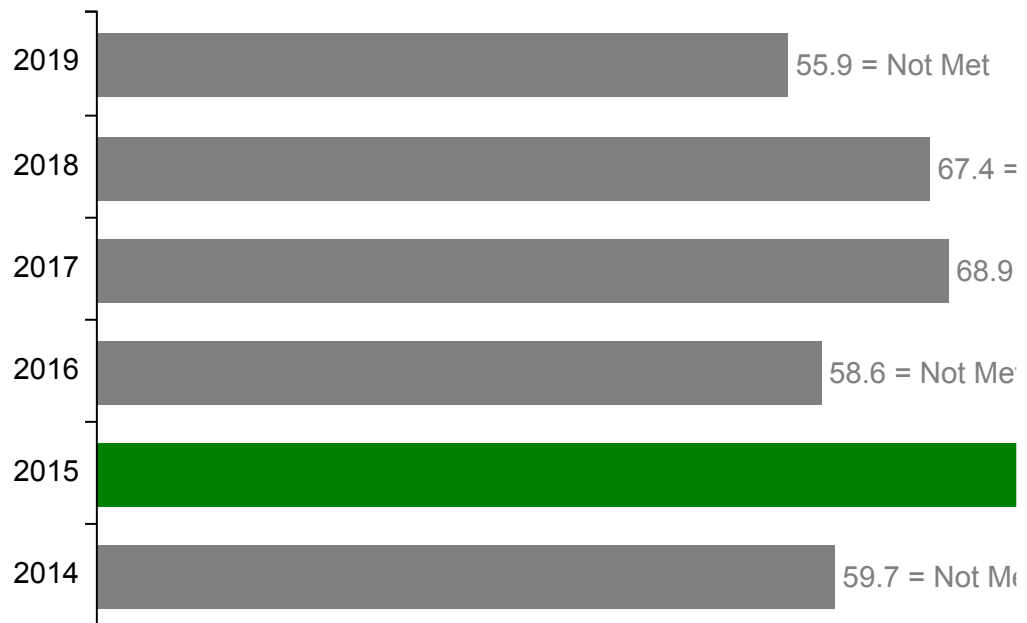

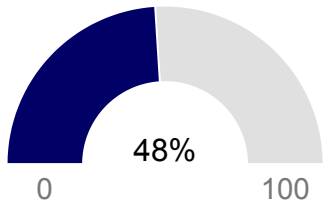

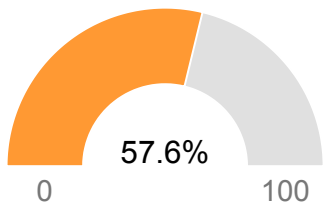

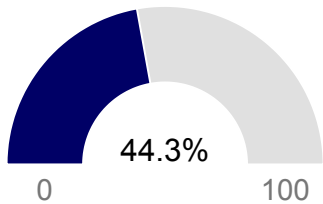

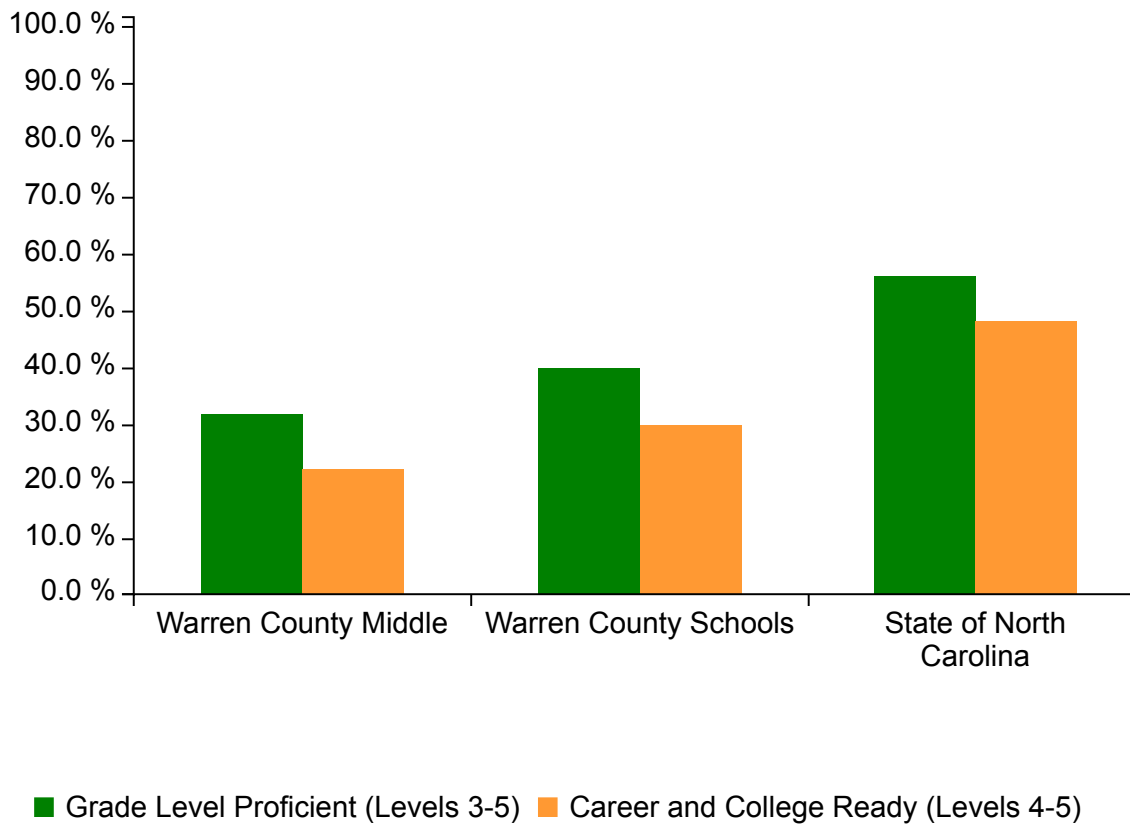

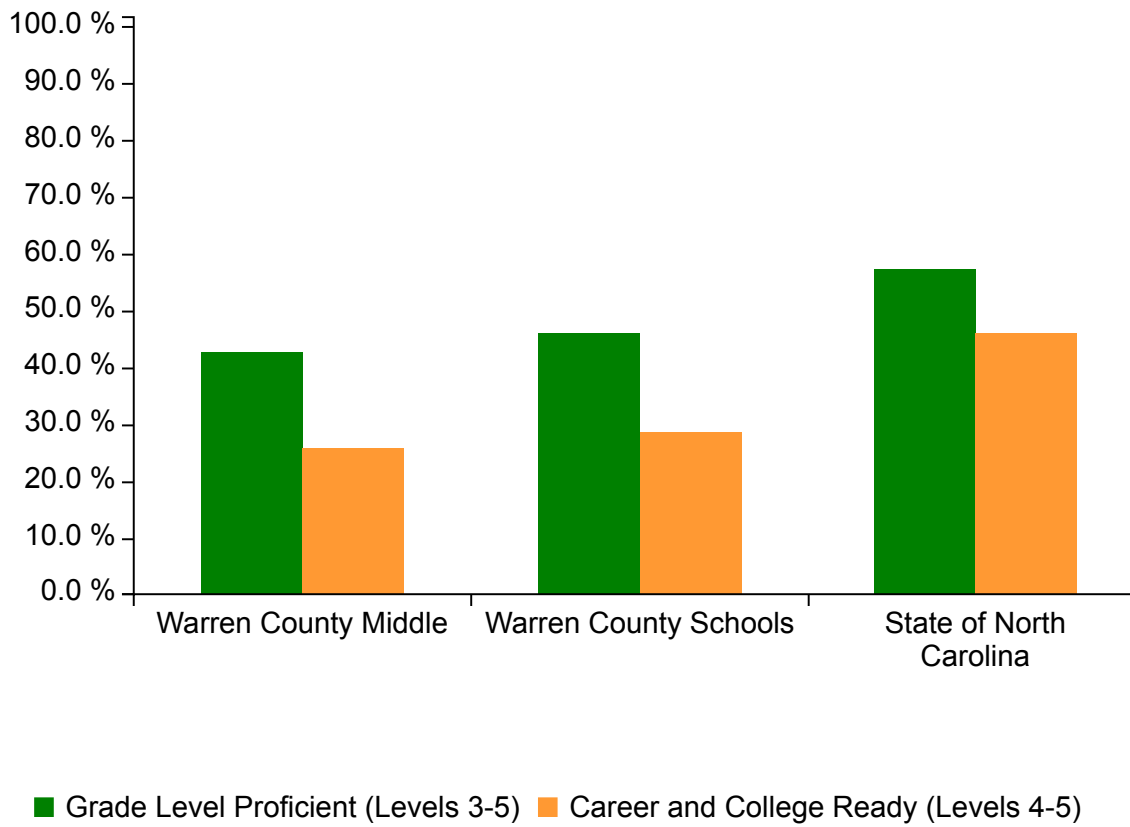

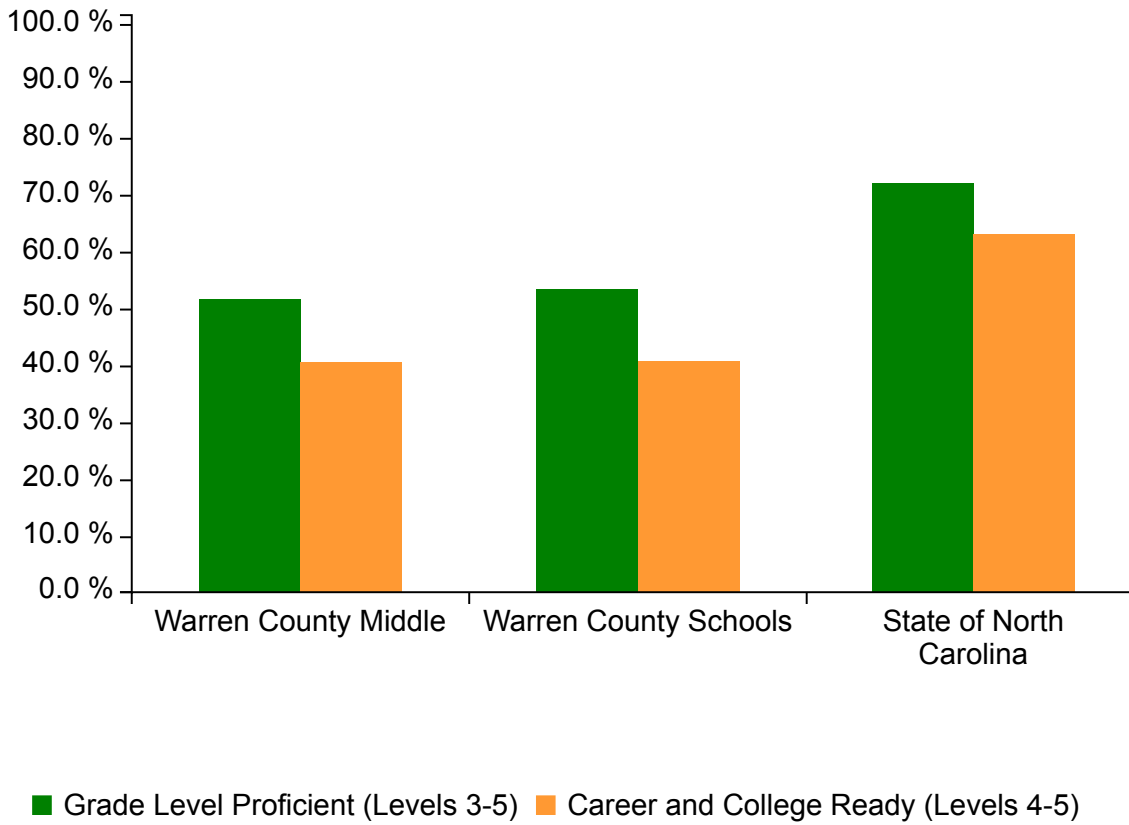

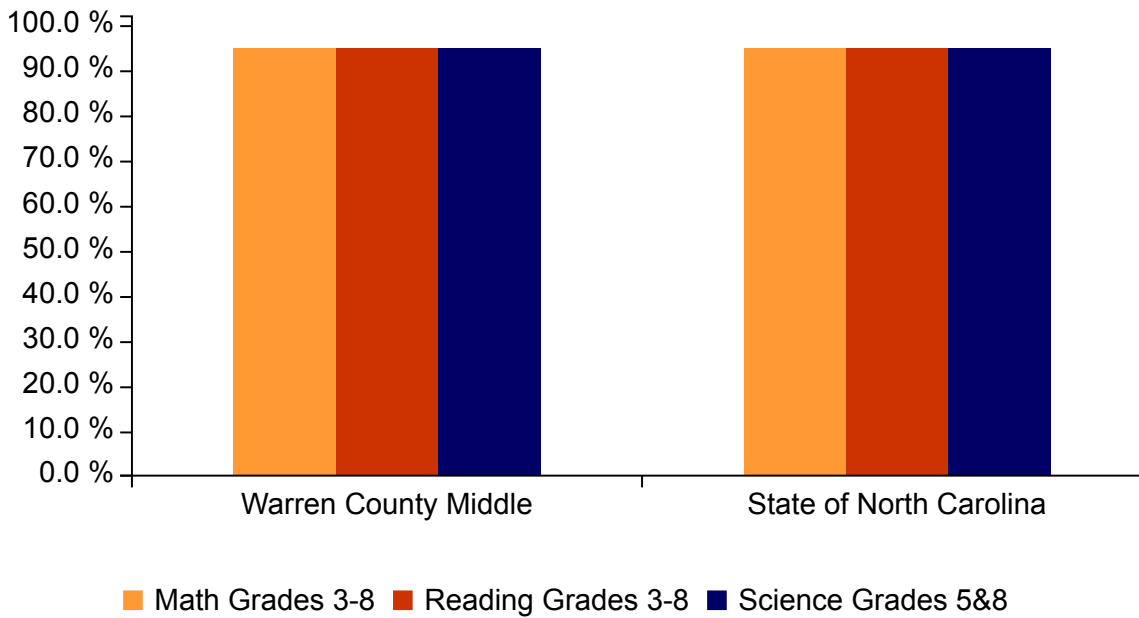

Students with Disabilities Alternate Test Participation

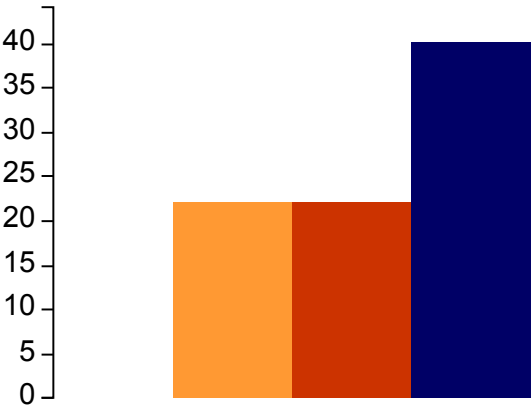

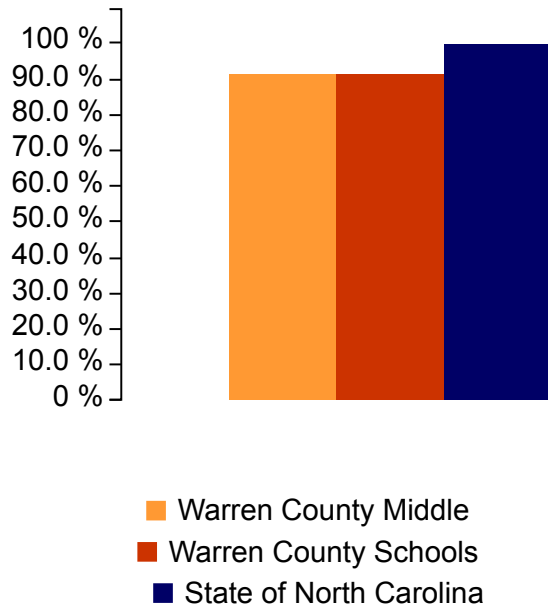

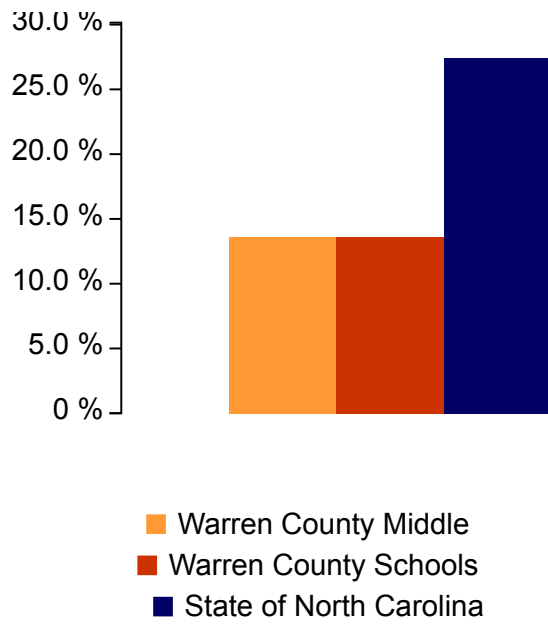

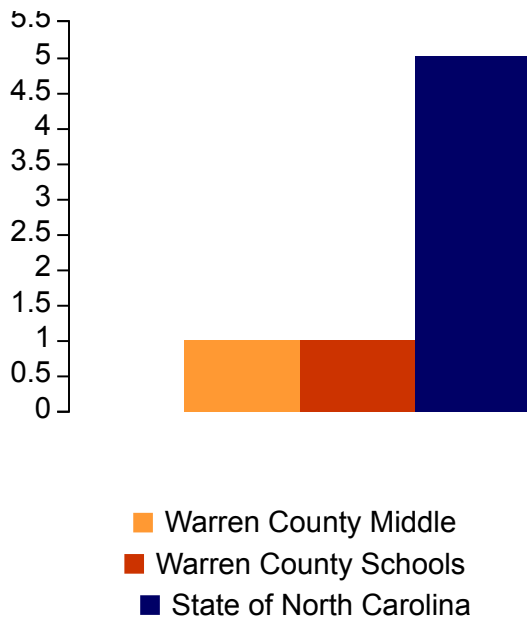

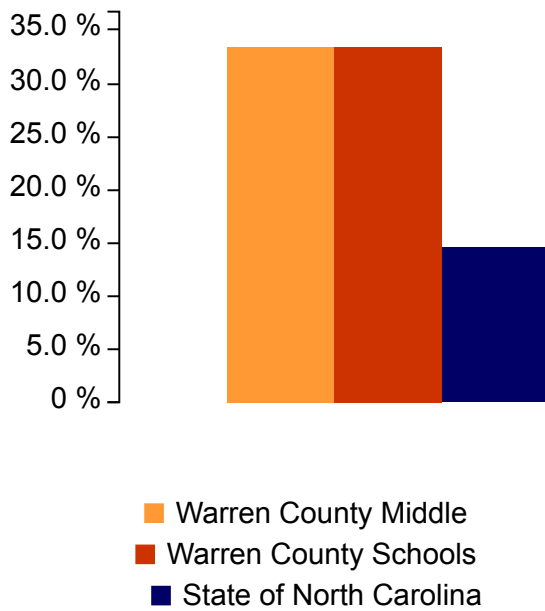

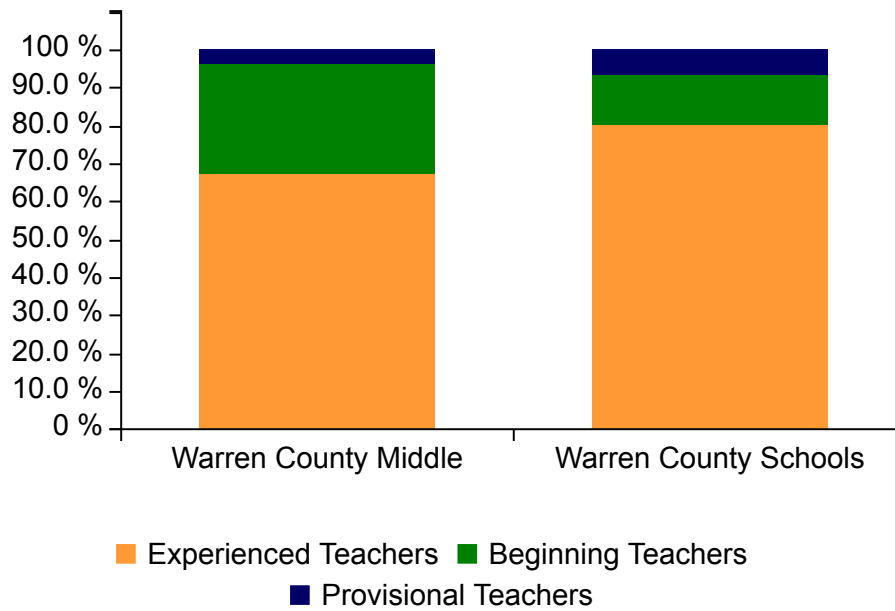


One Year Teacher Turnover Rate i

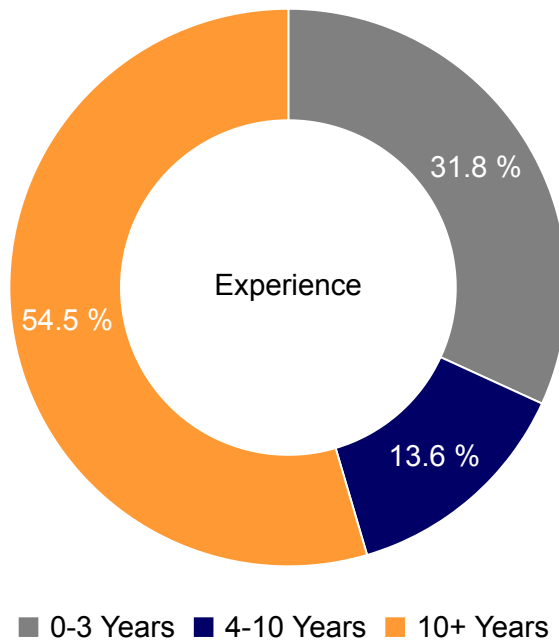

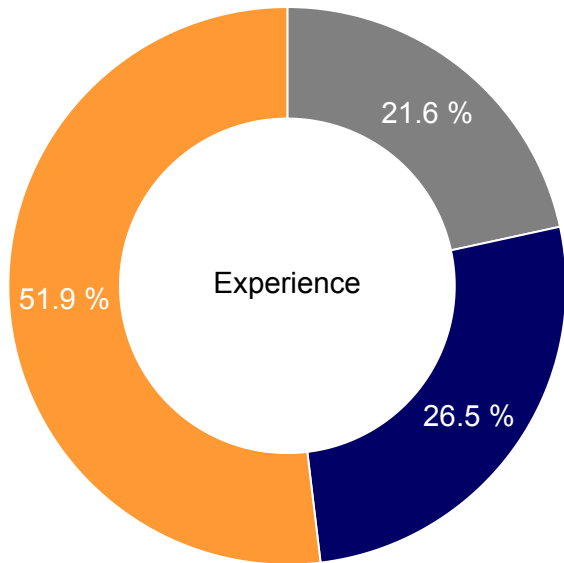

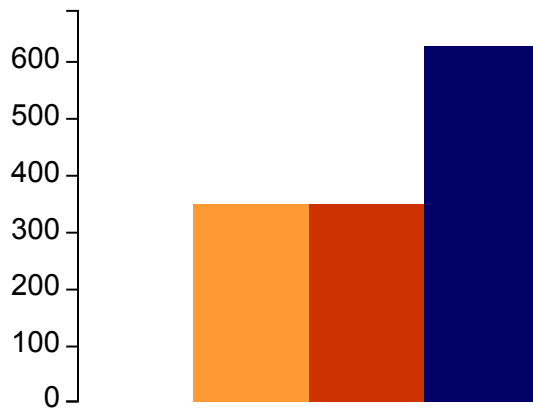

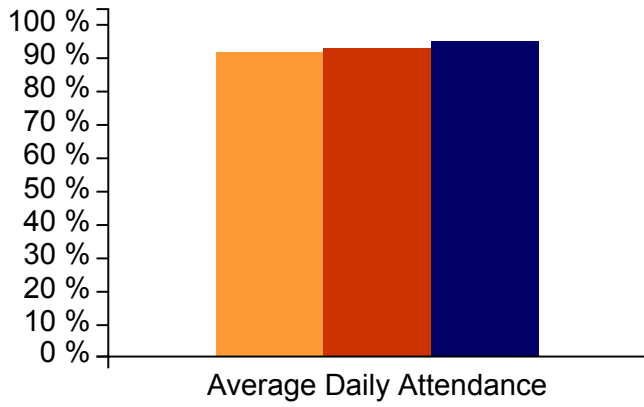

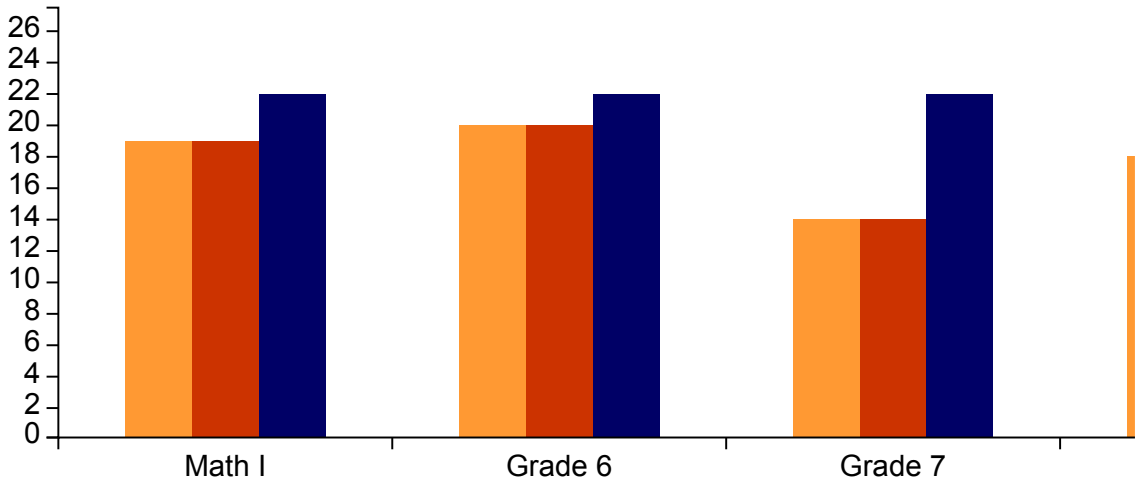

Suspension and Expulsion Rates (per 1000 students) ⓘ

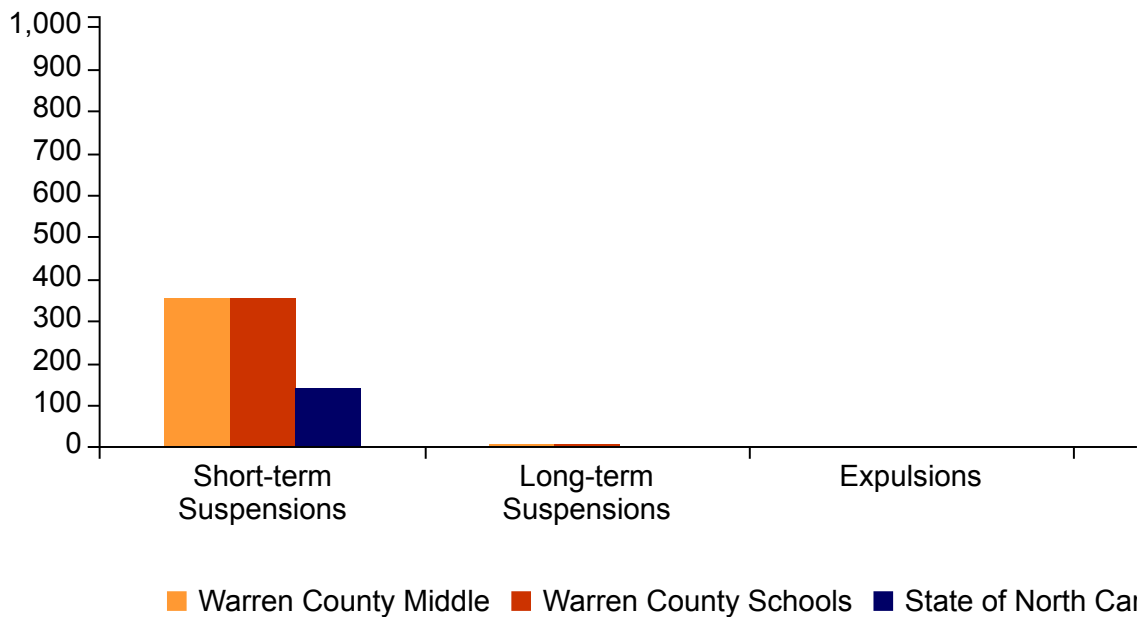
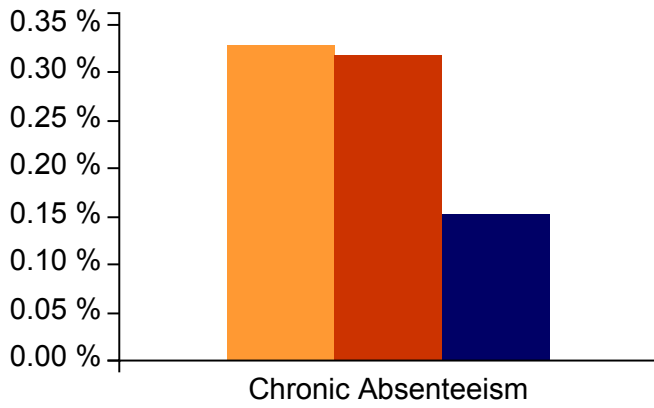

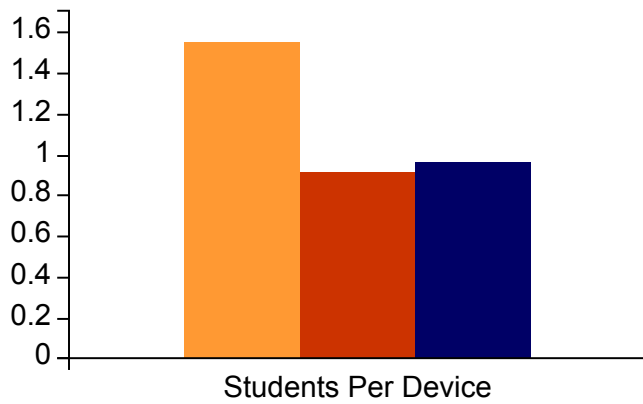
Chronic Absenteeism **i**

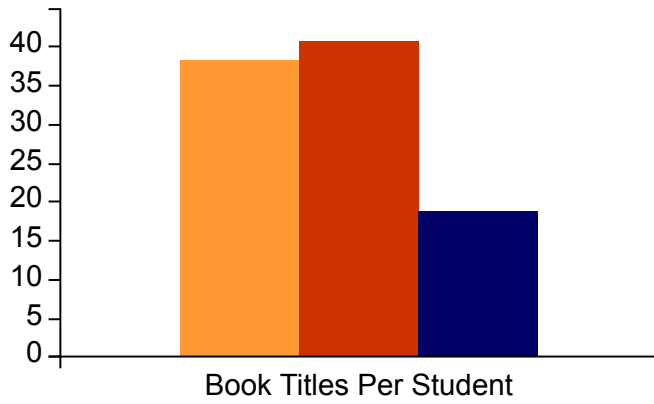
Students Per Device ⓘ

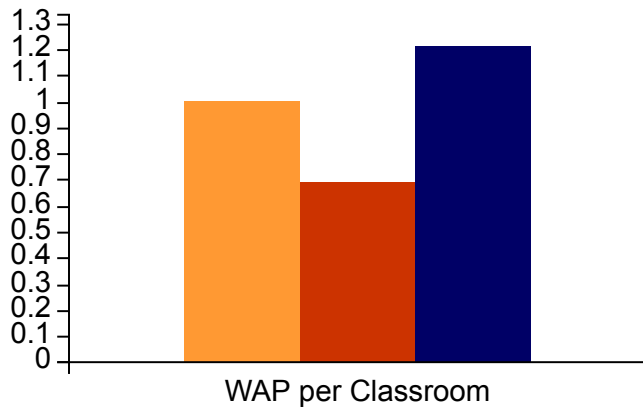
Book Titles Per Student ⓘ
