## Return to School Plan Highlights Second Semester

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### INSTRUCTION

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- Families may choose between the on-campus model or the all off-campus virtual model.
  - Families are asked to make their selection for the semester

#### ON-CAMPUS LEARNING OPTION

- K-12 students attending in-person will be on-campus for a shortened day Tuesday-Friday. Mondays will be asynchronous learning off-campus.
  - Middletown Prairie: 8:30-2:00
  - Lincoln Trail: 8:45-2:15
  - Junior High: 9:30-3:05
  - High School: 9:35-3:21

#### VIRTUAL OFF-CAMPUS LEARNING OPTION

- Mahomet Seymour off-campus learning will be a completely online learning platform supported by Mahomet-Seymour teachers.
  - K-5: Students will be assigned to a Mahomet-Seymour teacher's virtual classroom of all online learners.
  - 6-12: Students will either participate synchronously with Mahomet-Seymour classes following the building bell schedule.

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### TRANSPORTATION

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- Specific routing information, including times, will be shared with families prior to the start of school.
- Routes limited to 50 riders
- Assigned seats on all bus routes
- Masks required for all drivers, monitors, and riders
- Cleaning/disinfecting buses after every route

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## **FOOD SERVICES**

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- All food will be plated or bagged. No buffets or bars will be available until further notice.
- Training through ARBOR Management will be provided to all kitchen staff to ensure proper food service procedures.

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## **ACTIVITIES**

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- The district will follow IHSA/IESA guidance for all activities. Decisions regarding non-IHSA/IESA sanctioned activities will be discussed by building administration to determine if events, clubs, meetings can occur.

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## **HUMAN RESOURCES**

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- Safety of students and staff remains our number one priority. This commitment to safety requires that masks be worn inside at all times and that to the extent possible social distancing is practiced. To protect some individuals, shields may be worn or barriers (e.g., plexiglass) installed.
- Guidelines regarding FMLA, specific to COVID, will be communicated with staff.

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## **OPERATIONS & MAINTENANCE**

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- Increased and more thorough cleaning schedule, including increased cleaning of high traffic areas and restrooms
- Signage with social distancing, masking, and handwashing reminders added throughout buildings

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- Kids Club child care will be available for before school, after school, and on Mondays for students in Grades K-5.
