SPECIAL BOARD OF EDUCATION MEETING – July 27, 2020

Board President, Jim Rudeen, called the special meeting of the Board of Education of Mission Valley USD #330 to order at 7:00 p.m. in the Elementary lunch room at Mission Valley Schools. The meeting was also available via Zoom. Board members present were Mistina Kraus, Clinton Lambotte, Jon Deters and Jacob Durkes. Tuff Stephenson and Clipper Goodrich were absent. The superintendent and board clerk also attended.

Mistina Kraus moved, seconded by Jacob Durkes, to approve the agenda as presented. Motion passed 5 to 0.

Clinton Lambotte moved, seconded by Jon Deters, to publish the notice of hearing of the 2020-2021 budget as presented in the Wabaunsee County Signal-Enterprise on July 30, 2020. Motion passed 5 to 0.

Clipper Goodrich joined the meeting at 7:08 p.m.

The superintendent reviewed a portion of the school re-opening plan.

Jacob Durkes moved, seconded by Clipper Goodrich, to go into executive session at 7:45 p.m. to discuss the latest proposal for increasing the base pay rate for the teachers pursuant to the exception for employer-employee negotiations under KOMA, and that they return to open session in the same room at 8:05 p.m. Motion passed 6 to 0. The superintendent and board clerk also attended.

The meeting reconvened in open session at 8:05 p.m.

Jim Rudeen moved, seconded by Clipper Goodrich, to go back into executive session at 8:08 p.m. to discuss the latest proposal for increasing the base pay rate for the teachers pursuant to the exception for employer-employee negotiations under KOMA, and that they return to open session in the same room at 8:23 p.m. Motion passed 6 to 0. The superintendent and board clerk also attended.

Elementary Principal, Amy Johnston, joined executive session at 8:15 p.m. She left executive session at 8:18 p.m.

The meeting reconvened in open session at 8:23 p.m.

Clipper Goodrich moved, seconded by Clinton Lambotte, to approve that school for the 2020-2021 year start on August 20<sup>th</sup>. Motion passed 4 to 2, with Jim Rudeen and Jacob Durkes voting no.

Clinton Lambotte moved, seconded by Jon Deters, to adjourn the meeting. Motion passed 6 to 0. Meeting adjourned at 9:23 p.m.
