Policy 5050 Home Schools and/or Schools Not Meeting Approval and Accreditation Regulations

Students in Nebraska may choose to be educated at a home school that meets the requirements of statute and the Nebraska Department of Education. The board of education encourages the parents and guardians of all schoolage children who reside within the school district to enroll them in the public school or an approved or accredited private school so they may benefit from a well-planned education program and the socialization of a group environment.

The school district's administration will inform the appropriate agency of the names of all students who are school age and known not to be in attendance at a public, private, or parochial school that has met the requirements for legal operation prescribed in statute and the rules of the Nebraska Department of Education.
