Back To School Immunization Clinics begin

Shelbyville, Illinois, July 27, 2020—The Shelby County Health Department will be offering walk-in immunization clinics on Monday, August 3rd from 8:00-11:30 AM and 1:00-6:00 PM and Tuesday, August 4th from 8:00-11:30 AM and 1:00-3:30 PM. The clinic is open to children 3 years of age to 18 years. No appointment is necessary. If you are bringing children that attend school outside Shelby County or are new to the school system, you must bring their immunization records for the nurse to evaluate. The Shelby County Health Department accepts all major insurance plans and is a In-Network provider with many PPOs and HMO plans. Anyone with private insurance is encouraged to call the health department in advance and pre-register to verify insurance eligibility. If your child is not covered by insurance, the health department participates in the Vaccine for Children program and offers low cost options. All consents must be signed by a parent or legal guardian and are valid for 30 days. The health department asks clients to wear face masks and social distancing practices will be utilized to protect our clients and community. Please do not come to the immunization clinic if you have a fever or other symptoms of Covid-19.
