

## **Fairlane Elem.'s Re-opening of School Plan 2020-21**

### **Morning Arrival**

- All teachers and staff will have their temperature checked before entering the building through the front door.
- As students arrive, either by bus or car, they will have their temperature checked. If temperature is below 100.4F, Kindergarten students will proceed into the cafeteria and sit at a designated table with their class. 1st Grade students will proceed to the playroom and sit in a designated area with their class. If a student has a temperature at or above 100.4 the proper procedures will be followed.
- At the morning bell students will be dismissed by classes to walk in single file to their classrooms.
- Students will be given breakfast as they leave to head to their classroom. Students will eat breakfast in their classroom.

### **Classrooms**

- Once students are in their classroom they will stay in this cohort with minimal, to no contact with other cohorts (classrooms) in the school building.
- Teachers will utilize teaching techniques that minimize prolonged student to student interactions when possible.
- Students will use their own materials whenever possible. If shared materials are required these will be cleaned after each use.
- Throughout the day teachers will monitor students. The teacher will follow the proper procedures for any student exhibiting sickness symptoms.

### **Pull-outs**

- When students attend pull-outs such as P.E., library, computer lab, music, art, and guidance they will stay within their cohort.
- Teachers of these pull-outs will clean any used materials before the next cohort attends.
- RTI, Sp.Ed., & ELL Pull-outs; students will have their temperature taken before entering the classroom of this pull-out. If a student has a temperature the proper procedures will be followed. Teachers will keep smaller groups together at tables throughout the whole

intervention time and social distance as much as possible. Any used materials will be cleaned before the next group attends.

### **Hallways, Restrooms & Waterfountains**

- While in the hallways, cohorts will stay in a single line to the right or left against the wall, social distancing from other cohorts.
- A restroom schedule will be developed for 1st Grade, with only one cohort using a restroom at time. Kindergarten students will use only the restrooms in their classrooms.
- Students will be given multiple demonstrations and instructions on proper handwashing, hygiene, and social distancing. This will be repeated as needed.
- All water fountains will be turned off. A refill station is hopefully inline to be installed. Students will be allowed to bring their own water bottles. Bottled water will be provided for those who don't have their own.

### **Lunch**

- Students will eat lunch in the cafeteria with their cohort.
- Each cohort will be placed at alternating tables to maintain social distancing between cohorts.
- Students will be dismissed by their cohort at the end of their lunch period.
- Tables will be properly cleaned after each cohort is finished with their lunch time.

### **Recess**

- Recess for each grade will be split into two sessions. With half of the cohorts participating in each time.
- The playground will be divided into stations for play. Cohorts will play in designated stations for the allotted amount of time before moving on to the next station.

### **Afternoon Dismissal**

- Students that are pick-ups will stay and sit with their cohort in the hallway against the wall. Social distancing will be maintained between each cohort.

- Students that ride buses will be put with other students riding the same bus. Each bus will be separated into their cohort and sit at a designated table in the cafeteria while maintaining social distancing.

### **Students with a fever of 100.4 or exhibiting symptoms of COVID**

- Any time a student has a fever of 100.4 or higher, that student will be sent to the nurses office and isolated. Parents will be contacted to come pick up their child.
- Any faculty or staff member with a fever of 100.4 will be sent home and asked to consult their doctor.
- Any student, faculty or staff member that is exhibiting symptoms of COVID but has no fever then the nurse will follow guidelines from the district as to how to proceed.

### **Cleaning and disinfection of school building**

- Janitors will clean classrooms and restrooms everyday as normal. Making sure to wipe down door handles, sink faucets, and toilet handles.
- Cafeteria tables will be cleaned and sanitized after each cohort is done with their lunch period.
- Teachers will clean items that are to be shared by students after each use.
- At the end of each day teachers will spray their student's desks, chairs and any other classroom furniture used by students with a disinfecting spray.
