Seniors!!! You can reserve and paint your very own parking spot for the 2023-2024 school year!

If you are a senior for the 2023-2024 school year and wish to have a FRONT ROW parking spot, you must:

- Complete a Senior Parking Design Request by August 11th.
- Complete a Senior Parking Spot Agreement
- All designs must be completed and submitted for review on or before you begin.
- Pay a \$30 FEE.

If you wish to drive a vehicle to school you must register for a student parking permit for the 2023-2024 school year.

Keep in mind all student code of conduct and all local laws will be enforced regarding the personalization process. Wording or marks of alcohol, drugs, drug paraphernalia, slander, slang, racism, gangs, or sexual connotation will lead to loss of privilege and/or punishment. At any time during the year, the QHS administrative team reserves the right to remove the Senior Parking Space Painting privilege if any of the above occurs.

Painting of Senior Parking Spaces 2023 – 2024:

Seniors will be painting their parking spaces from August 7 through August 13.

In order to follow all county and district codes, please note the guidelines below that must be followed for the painted parking spaces and sign stating that you will oblige and understand that if the guidelines aren't followed your privileges will be revoked.

- Students must stay within the 8ft by 8ft template. (The template will be placed by Admin and traced with chalk to designate the space. It is recommended that painters tape be placed to keep the straight line and correct size.)
- Students who are approved for painting a parking space must select an available space on the front row.
- Any artwork depicting items, symbols, or language that QHS administration deems inappropriate will not be allowed.

Students driving to school must have a QHS parking permit, present a current TX driver's license and valid insurance, and have a license plate number to reserve a parking spot. All designs must be completed on the Senior Parking Design Request form and returned to the front office for approval by August 10, 2023.

Your design should be clearly drawn on the following form and must include the colors you will be using on your parking space. On your design sheet, please include your first and last name, email address, and cell phone number where you can be reached. Once your design has been reviewed, the high school office will let you know if any changes need to be made.

STUDENT PARKING SPACE RULES

- 1. You MUST purchase your own paint. (It takes gallons per spot, not quarts.)
- 2. You must paint within 8ft.by 8ft. template. Do not cover parking lines or numbers
- 3. Students must clean spills and must discard all unused materials.
- 4. All parking spots will be assigned on a first come first serve basis. You must be in person to reserve your spot. There will be no "reserving spots" for other students.
- 5. **HAVE FUN**; the purpose of allowing students to paint their own parking spot is aimed at improving school pride and camaraderie. Students can "own" a piece of the school for a year. We encourage students to express themselves through positive artwork.
- 6. Paint your name (at least your first name) somewhere on your spot.
- 7. Having students park in these reserved spots helps deter someone parking in a spot they aren't assigned.

All designs are due to High School Administrators in the QHS front office. There will be time to review designs and communicate with seniors any of the changes that need to be made. Students may start dropping off design requests as early as Wednesday, July 26, 2023 @ 9:00AM to the front office. If you have any questions, please contact the front office at 903-763-5000.

Remember, painting a student parking spot is completely optional. There will be parking available for students who do not wish to decorate a parking spot. These students only pay the \$10 for a parking permit.

Prohibited items will be painted over at the discretion of the Administration. Loss of privilege or disciplinary action could result from displaying prohibited items. If this happens, you'll be forfeiting your right to a parking space and possibly to drive on campus.

Senior Parking Design Request

This design sheet must be done in color and must represent exactly what will be painted on your parking space if it is accepted. You may start <u>submitting drawings</u> at 9:00 a.m. on Wednesday, July 26, 2023. The deadline to submit drawings is Thursday, August 10, 2023 at 3:00 p.m.

Parking spot painting is August 7 - 13(once you have approval).

Remember: Design will be 8ft by 8 ft.
