JCSD Virtual Academy Question/Answer Sheet

- Would my child's teacher be local or someone on-line?
 Both- virtual students will receive instruction on-line and from JCSD teachers.
- Can my student take AP classes through the virtual classroom?
 Yes, AP courses are available through Virtual Arkansas.
- Can my student take virtual classes and still participate in the IGNITE program through ASUN?
 Yes
- 4. Can a student switch from virtual to on site or on site to virtual if conditions get worse?
 Each case will be considered individually, our goal is to use every half nine week mark (4 & ¹/₂ week) as the appropriate time to change.
- Can a student be counted absent if they are enrolled in virtual school?
 No
- How will testing work if my student is home enrolled in virtual school?
 Students will set up an appointment for standardized testing times in the Spring.
 3-8 students will have to set up an appointment for interim testing 3 times a year.
 The building principal will be in contact when those times are available.
- Can my student be an Honor Graduate if enrolled in virtual school? Students must follow handbook guidelines in the JCSD student handbook referencing Honor Graduate requirements.
- What if my child has a 504 Plan, will those accommodations still apply?
 Yes, the 504 coordinator, parent and teacher will need to re-evaluate the 504 plan and determine if any accommodations should be adjusted.
- What are the procedures for Special Education/Supplemental Services?
 An appointment will need to be scheduled with SPED team. This can be scheduled through the student's teacher.
- 10. Will my child be able to participate in Athletics and other extracurricular activities? Yes, we encourage our students to participate in extracurricular activities.

- 11. Does the virtual schedule mirror the typical school day? Yes, some of the activities and instruction will be delivered during the scheduled period of the school day via zoom.
