# DAILY WELLNESS CHECK



Please ensure this is completed daily prior to sending your child to school.

## SECTION 1: Symptoms

- Fever (100.4 or greater) or chills
- Sore throat
- New uncontrolled cough that causes difficulty breathing (for students with chronic allergy/asthmatic cough, a change in their cough from baseline)
- Diarrhea, vomiting, abdominal pain
- New onset of severe headache, especially with fever

- Had close contact with a person with confirmed SARS-CoV-2; OR
- Had close contact with a person under quarantine or possible exposure to COVID-19; OR
- Traveled to an area with large numbers of COVID-19 cases
- Lives in an area with high community transmission

## SECTION 2: Close Contact or Potential Exposure

If answers YES to any questions in Section 1 but NO to any questions in Section 2, the student would be excused from school in accordance with existing school illness policy (symptom-free, fever-free for 24 hours without fever reducing medications).

If answers YES to any questions in Section 1 and YES to any questions in Section 2, students should refer to a healthcare provider for evaluation. If tested for SARS-CoV-2 and have received negative test results, students may return once symptoms have improved and are in accordance with regular school illness policy. Students diagnosed with COVID-19 should follow protocol from their provider and local health department.
