Goals

- Increase the percentage of students meeting the College and Career Readiness Standards as measured by the annual ACT Aspire and ACT Assessments.
 - 2012 Target - 2% increase
 - 2020 Target - 3% Increase
 - 2022 Target - 4% Increase
- Total 3 year increase of 9%



What are we going to do at SHS?

- Provide ongoing ACT and ACT Aspire training to teachers
- Professional Learning Communities (PLC) will be used to analyze data
- Incorporate ACT prep bell ringers into instruction
- Analyze ACT Aspire Interim assessment data
- Provide Critical Reading classes
- Continue to reduce out of school suspensions
- Continue to reduce absences
- Continue to provide before school tutoring and flex day for enrichment and remediation

- Summative ACT Aspire and ACT data - August
- Classroom Walkthrough data - Ongoing
- Student grades - Ongoing
- Student discipline data - Ongoing
- Student absences data - Ongoing
- Classroom assessment data

Ready for Learning Goals: Level 1 Limited Response

All students will attend school 5 days a week.

Ready for Learning Goals: Level 2 Moderate Response

Ready for Learning Goals: Level 3 Critical Response

All instruction will be provided through Google Classroom.

Students may utilize hotspots in the community to download content.

Tutors will be available for students to receive help as needed.

Teachers will be available during regular school hours to assist students.
