EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2012-HS7 RESCINDING

EXECUTIVE ORDER NOS. 2012-HS1, 2012-HS2, AND 2012-HS3

TOWNSHIP OF OLD BRIDGE

WHEREAS, Hurricane Sandy struck along the New Jersey Coast and brought severe weather conditions including heavy rains, high winds, dangerous storm surges and stream and river flooding that damaged homes and other structures and endangered lives in the State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, Governor Chris Christie declared a Statewide Weather State of Emergency on Saturday, October 27, 2012; and

WHEREAS, Hurricane Sandy directly impacted the health, safety and welfare of residents, damaged local properties and caused widespread power outages throughout the Township of Old Bridge; and

WHEREAS, the Nor'easter on Wednesday, November 7, 2012 brought additional severe weather conditions including rain, ice and snow that further impacted the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Township of Old Bridge; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority of Executive Order No. 104 issued by Governor Chris Christie on October 27, 2012 declaring a State of Emergency for the State of New Jersey it was necessary to enact certain Executive Orders in order to ensure that health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Township of Old Bridge; and

WHEREAS, the State of Emergency that necessitated the issuance of the Executive Orders referenced herein has abated and the need for same no longer exists, thereby negating the need for same.

NOW THEREFORE, I, OWEN HENRY, MAYOR OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OLD BRIDGE, hereby rescind Executive Orders No. 2012-HS1 (State of Emergency in the Township of Old Bridge), No. 2012-HS2 (Mandatory Evacuations) and No. 2012-HS3 (Travel Restrictions) that were enacted in order to protect the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Township of Old Bridge before, during and after both storm events.
