EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2015-SE1

TOWNSHIP OF OLD BRIDGE

WHEREAS, the National Weather Service has reported that there is expected a severe winter storm with heavy snow accumulations, mixed precipitation, strong winds and freezing temperatures throughout New Jersey. beginning on Monday, January 26, 2015, and

WHEREAS, Governor Chris Christie declared a statewide weather state of emergency ahead of the winter storm, Monday, January 26, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the impending storm is predicted to produce hazardous travel conditions, potential flooding conditions and potential power outages and have the potential to directly threaten the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Township of Old Bridge; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority of Executive Order No. 172 issued by Governor Chris Christie on January 26, 2015 declaring a State of Emergency for the State of New Jersey;

NOW THEREFORE, I, OWEN HENRY, MAYOR OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OLD BRIDGE, in order to protect the health, safety and welfare of Old Bridge Residents, do hereby declare and proclaim a State of Emergency within the Township of Old Bridge. Additional executive orders declaring non-emergency vehicles off public roads, curfews, mandatory evacuations and/or such other conditions as may be required as the result of this State of Emergency may be issued as weather conditions change and develop over the next seventy-two (72) hours.

This order should take effect immediately and shall remain in effect until such time as it is determined by me that an emergency no longer exists in the Township of Old Bridge.
