



Animal Licensing Application

➤ **PAYMENT** – Please make sure to include proper payment

- **Dog**
 - If Spayed/ neutered **\$10.00 (Ten dollars)** per dog
 - If not Spayed/ Neutered **\$13.00 (thirteen dollars)** per dog
- **Cat**
 - If Spayed/ neutered **\$10.00 (ten dollars)** per Cat
 - If not Spayed/ Neutered **\$13.00 (thirteen dollars)** per Cat

- NO CREDIT OR DEBIT CARDS ACCEPTED
- Checks made payable to the Township of Old Bridge Clerk
- Cash, preferably exact change (in person only)

- Dogs and cats are **not required** to be neutered. If the dog or cat is not neutered/ spayed a population control fee of \$3.00 will be added to the cost of the license.

- State law requires that your animals' **rabies vaccination must be valid through October 31 of the licensing year.** If your animals' rabies vaccination expires anytime between January and October of the current year, the animal **will need to be re-vaccinated** before a license can be issued.

- All animals must be licensed by March of each and every year, regardless of when a license was purchased the previous year. A **summons** can be issued for not purchasing a license any time after **March 1 of the current licensing year**.
- If at any time during the year, the town issued tag is *misplaced*, a replacement tag may be purchased in the Clerk's office for \$0.50 (fifty cents)
- If you should move or your animal has passed away during the year, kindly notify the Clerk's office by calling **(732)721-5600 extension 2299** or by e-mailing clerk@oldbridge.com so we may update our files.
- If application submitted or postmarked **after February 28, a \$5.00 (five dollar) late fee** will be added to the cost of the license for each animal.
