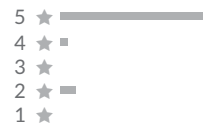
In-person student instruction on a modified schedule. So many of our students don't have access to technology and support at home. Even a half-day model would be better than current distance learning.

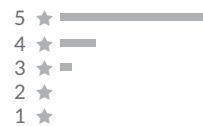
Kids who are not engaged in distance learning. Kids who are not supported at home are being left behind. We can call and talk to them, but we can't be there to help them when they are stuck.

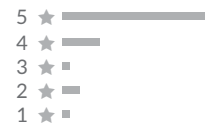

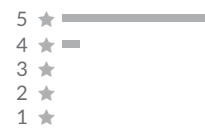
