Protocol for Routine Infection Prevention Cleaning and Disinfection

Routine Cleaning and Disinfection should follow [CDC Cleaning and Disinfecting Guidance](#) and includes disinfecting classrooms between groups, playground equipment between groups, restroom doors, faucet handles, etc.

Disinfecting kills germs on surfaces. By killing germs on a surface, it can further lower the risk of spreading infection. Following the cleaning of surfaces, use a disinfectant that is approved and safe to use.

All frequently touched surfaces and objects will be disinfected as much as possible.

- Facilities will be cleaned and disinfected at least daily to prevent transmission of the virus from surfaces.
- Disinfecting student desks/tables will take place when cohorts move between rooms.
- Cafeteria area will be cleaned and disinfected following use of student cohorts.
- All restrooms will be cleaned and disinfected three times a day.
- The isolation and sick rooms will be cleaned and disinfected following each student use.
- The playground and gym equipment will be disinfected following use of each student cohort.
- The hallways will be kept cleaned and disinfected throughout the day.

Protocol for Cleaning and Classroom Closure in case of COVID Case in a **Single Cohort**

If a student or staff member tests positive for COVID-19 the classroom and other areas used by the students and/or staff member will be thoroughly cleaned and disinfected. The custodial staff will follow CDC guidance.

Protocol for Cleaning after School-Wide Exposure

If the school is closed because of widespread virus outbreak, the custodial staff will use appropriate cleaners and disinfectants on all surfaces. The building will be thoroughly cleaned and disinfected using following CDC's guidance on disinfecting public spaces.
